Notes:

- LEA has negotiated for Connect, Equip 1 and Equip 2 to be recognised by the University of Divinity as suitable for inclusion in their Graduate Certificate in Education and Theology. Teachers who have successfully completed these in-service programs may apply for RPL for up to 50% of the award.
- As an alternative to completing Equip 1 and Equip 2 teachers may achieve accreditation Ac via an academic pathway. In this instance the Graduate Certificate in Education and Theology will consist of BS9004L Biblical Texts and Traditions, CT9004L Theological Foundations for Educators, DR9032 Teaching and Leading Christian Studies
- Teachers who completed:
 - Pathways prior to 2019 can complete the ePortfolio and submit it for recognition of prior learning (equivalent to one 12-point unit)
 - Equip prior to 2019 should contact Australian Lutheran College for advice on RPL. Email enquires@alc.edu.au
- All ALC graduates will need to complete Connect. Those who have completed the Lutheran strand or the GCTRE do not have to do Equip 1 or 2 but will normally substitute their Connect assessment portfolio with one which meets the requirements for accreditation as a Christian Studies teacher.
- The University of Divinity Graduate Certificate in Leadership which comprises DA9001L Leadership for a Christian Context (Core); DE9016L Education and Theology in Dialogue (Core); DE9035L Ethics, Values and Decision Making for Educators; DS9001L Spiritual Dimensions of Leadership in a Christian School
- LDP graduates meet Al (Accredited as a leader) requirements through completing ACU's Post Graduate Certificate in Educational Leadership as well as the LDP mentoring program and regional workshops
- Acl (Accredited as a Christian Studies teacher and leader) status applies to staff with Ac status who are subsequently appointed to, and meet the accreditation requirements for, a leadership position
- It is expected that all schools will offer one professional development day per year for staff formation and spiritual development. Accreditation can be maintained through participation in staff retreats, professional learning around the Lutheran lens (Ref Growing deep) for At and Ac staff, and through school based or regional Christian Studies days, DAN or AARE conferences for Ac staff.
- Accreditation to work in Lutheran education will be granted to staff who do not hold a teaching degree and requires the completion of Connect which can include a school based option for Session 4 (for RPL 12 points).
