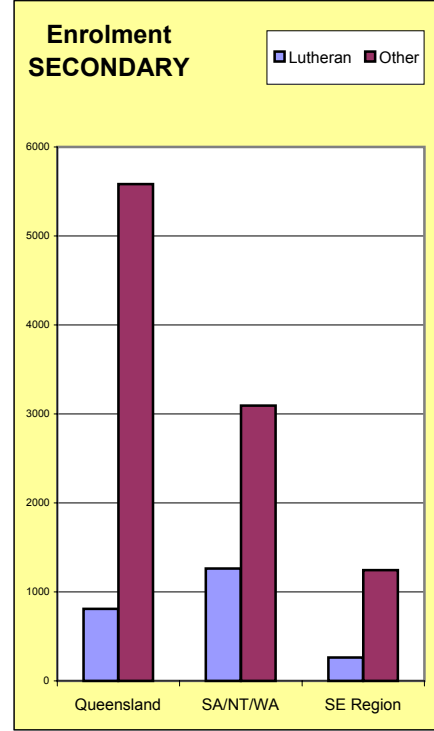
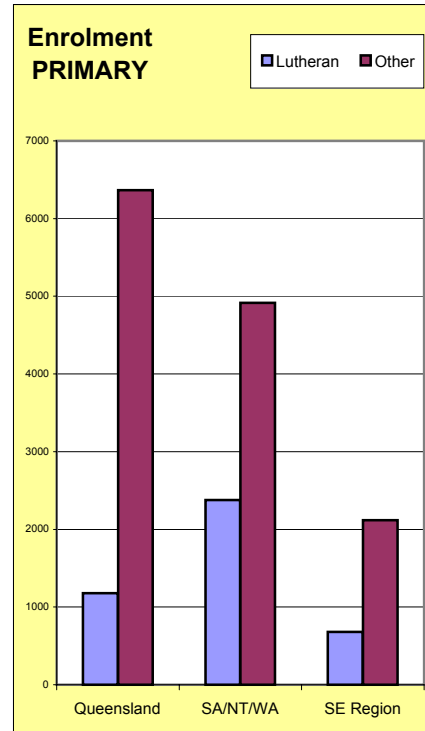
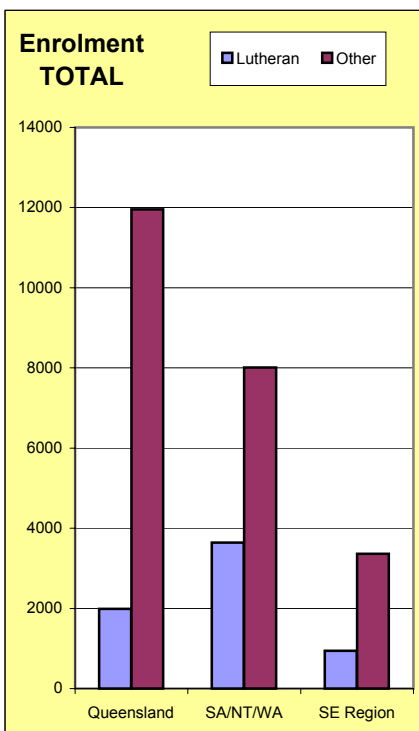
Enrolment by region



Enrolment by religion



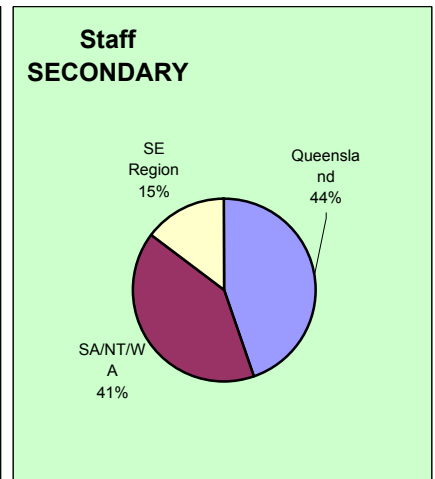
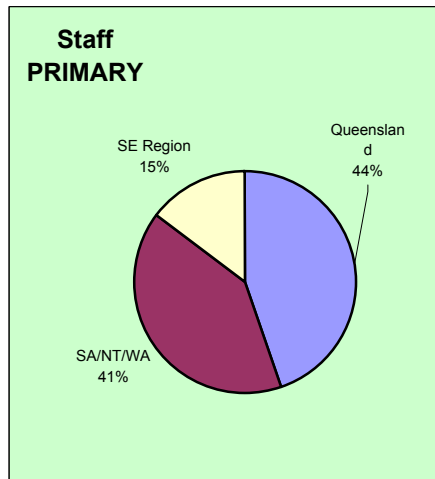
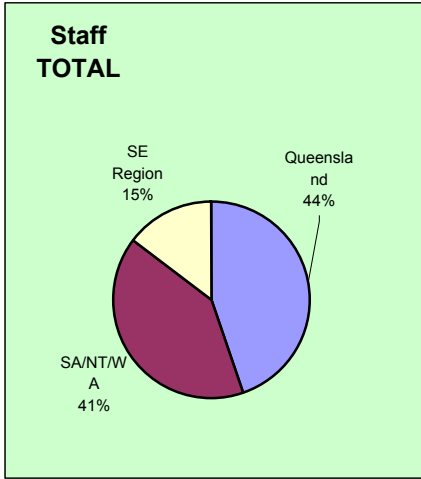
Enrolment by region and religion



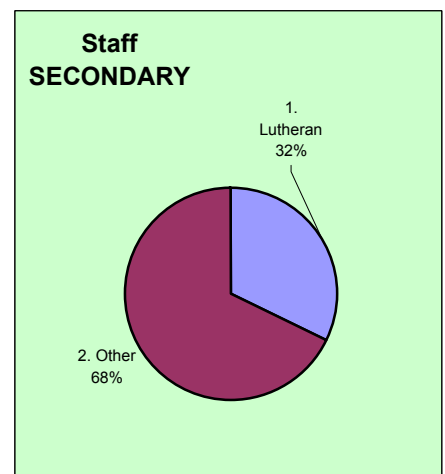
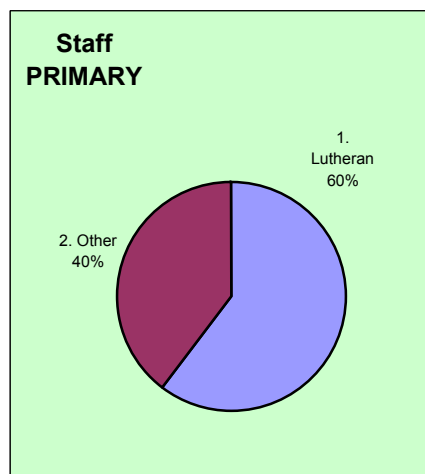

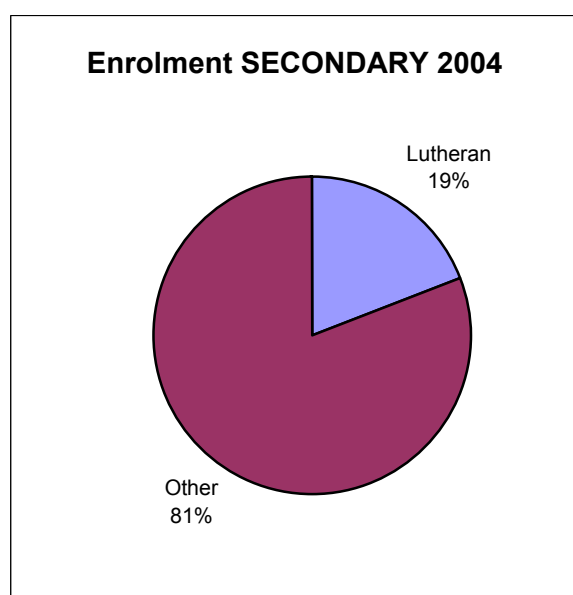
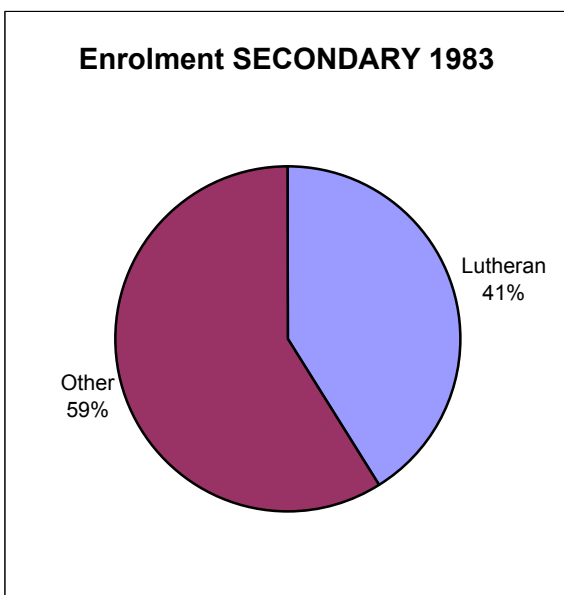
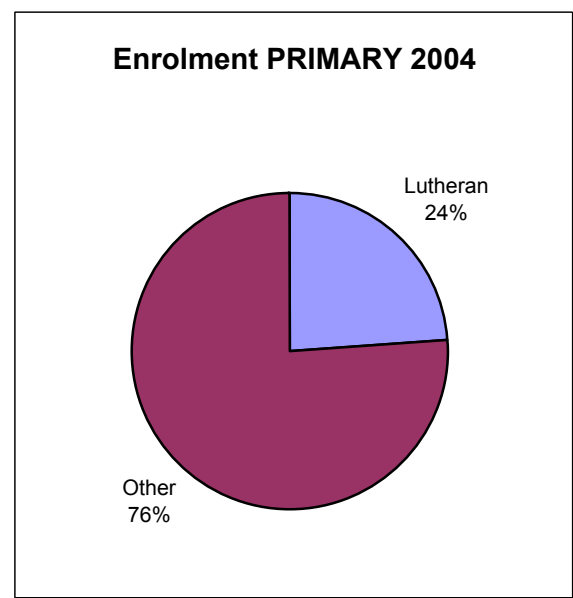
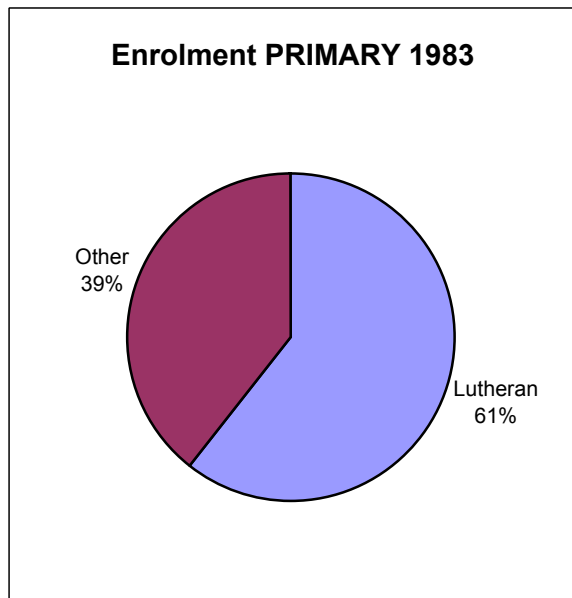
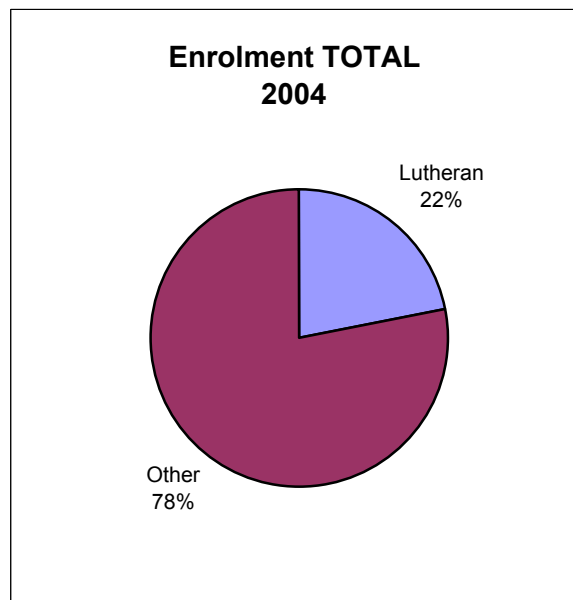
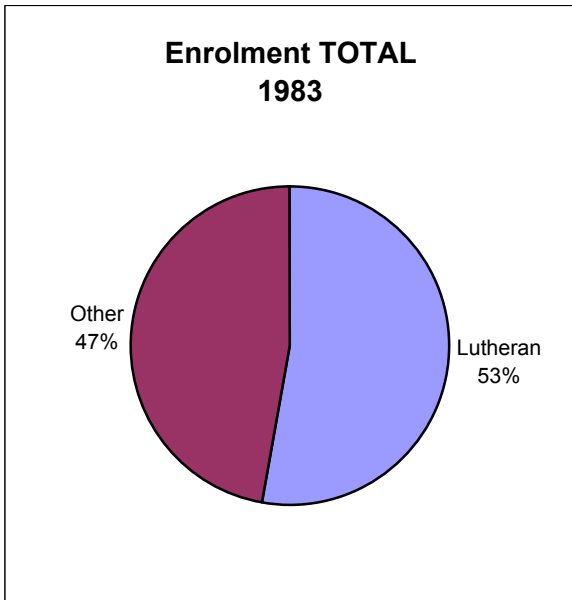
TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2004 National



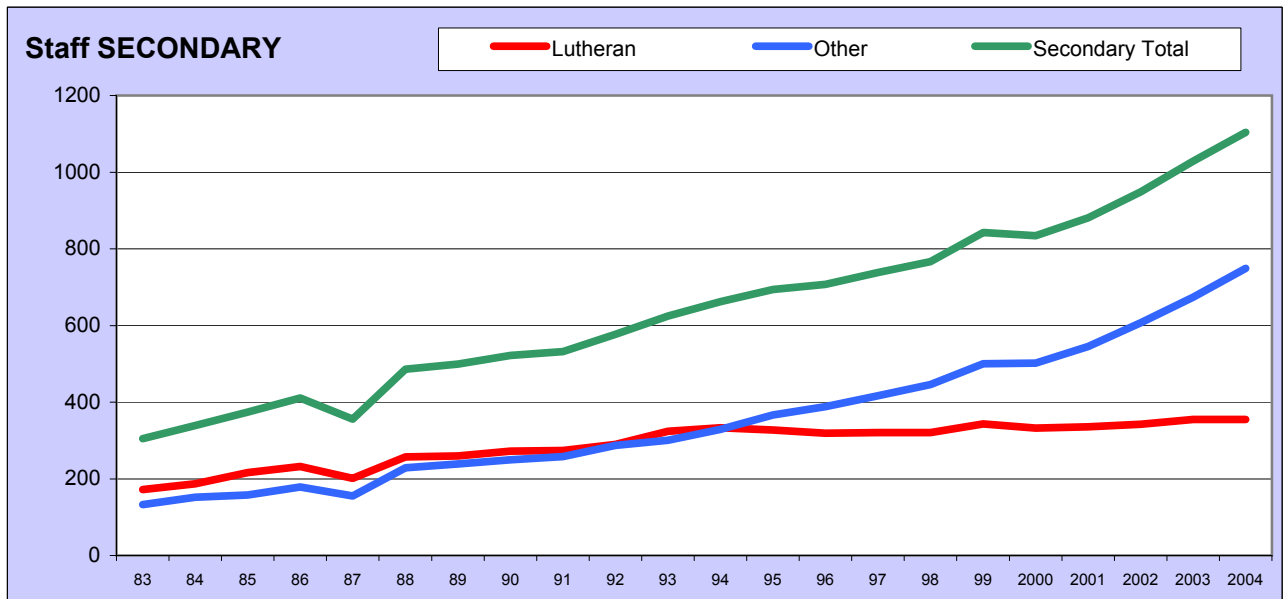
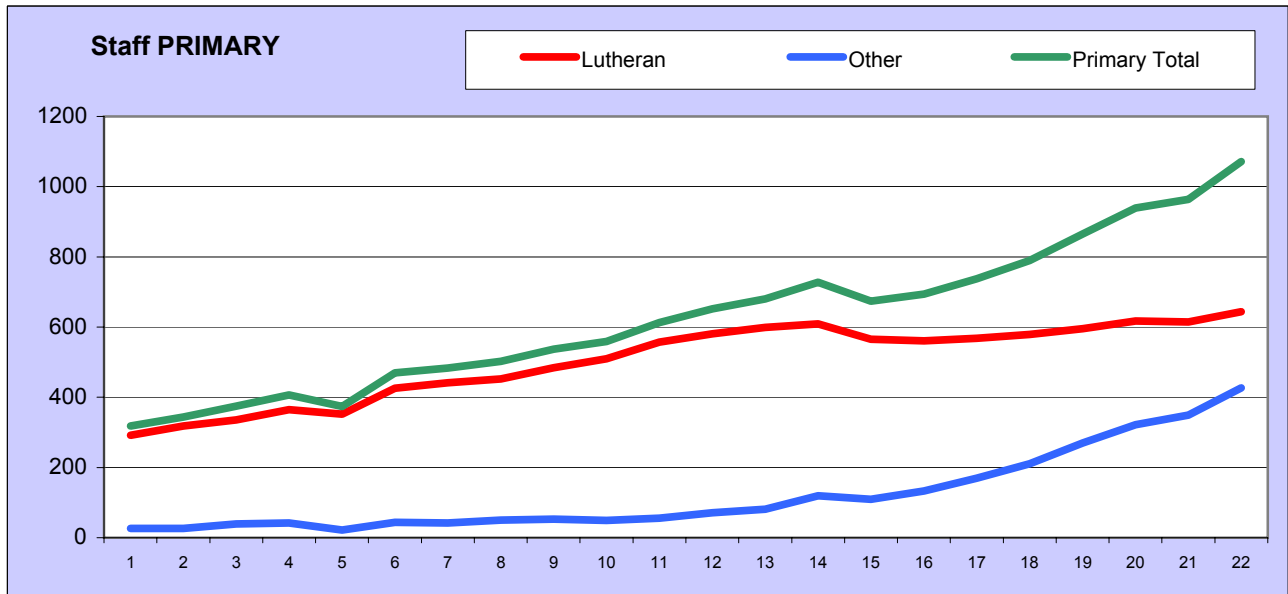
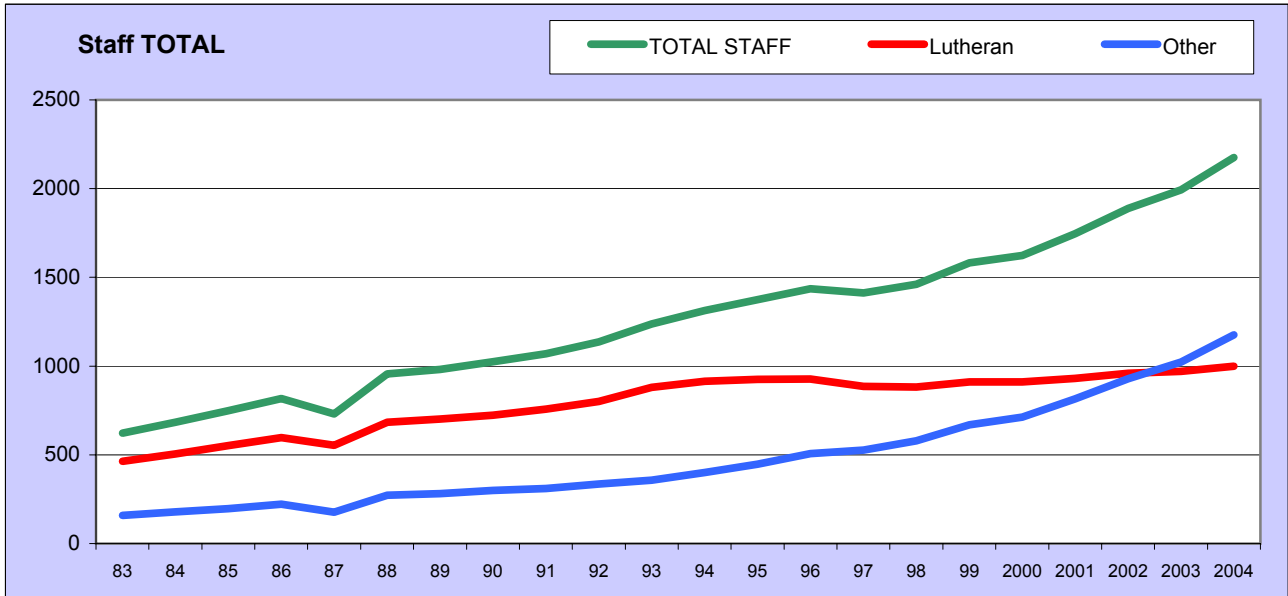
TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2004 by region



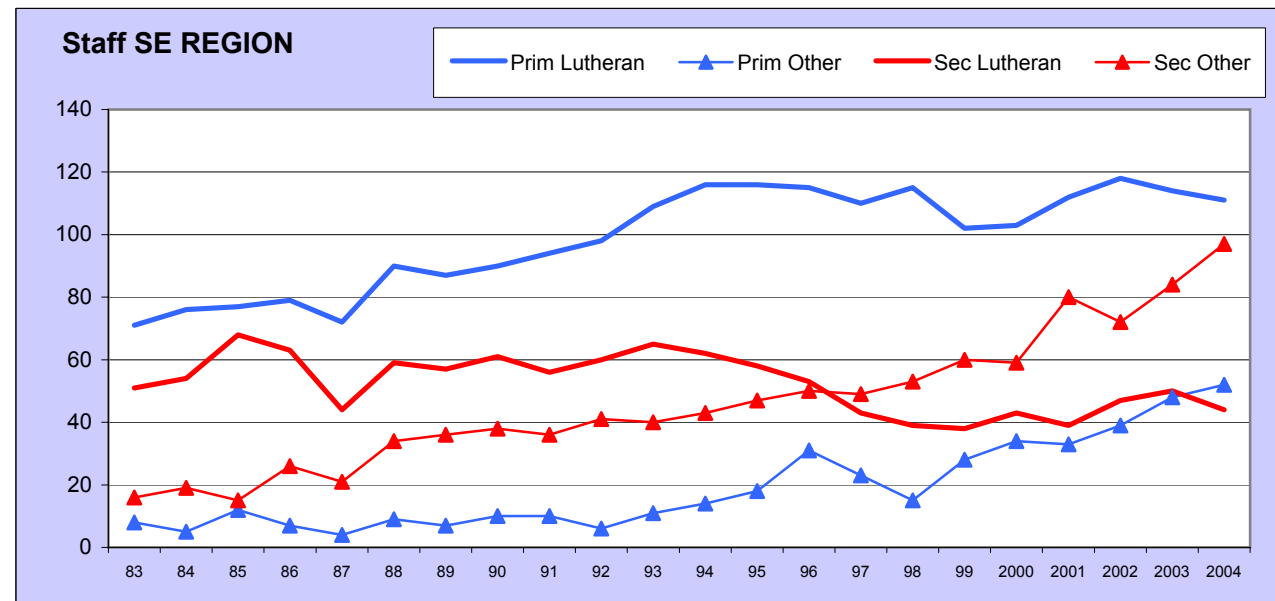
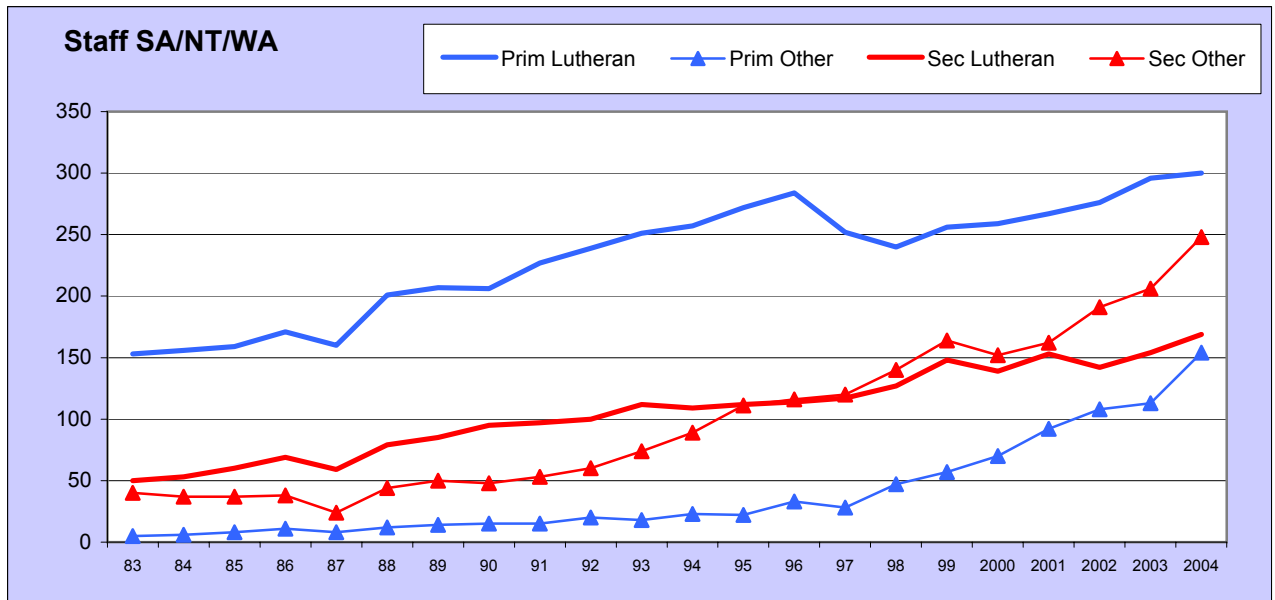
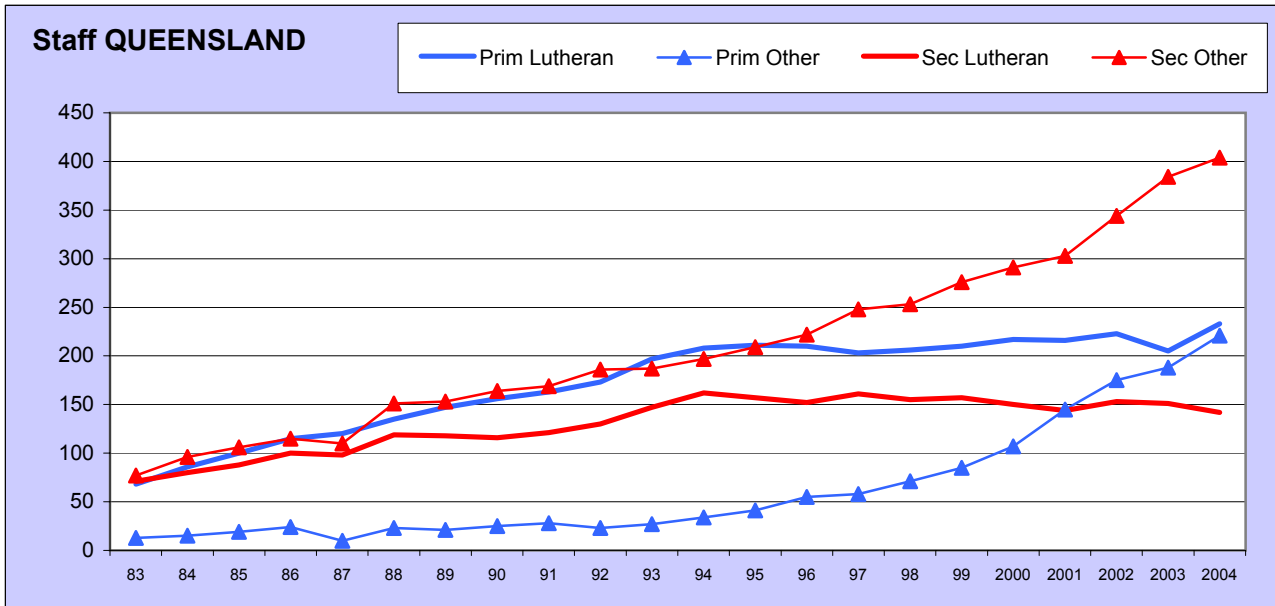

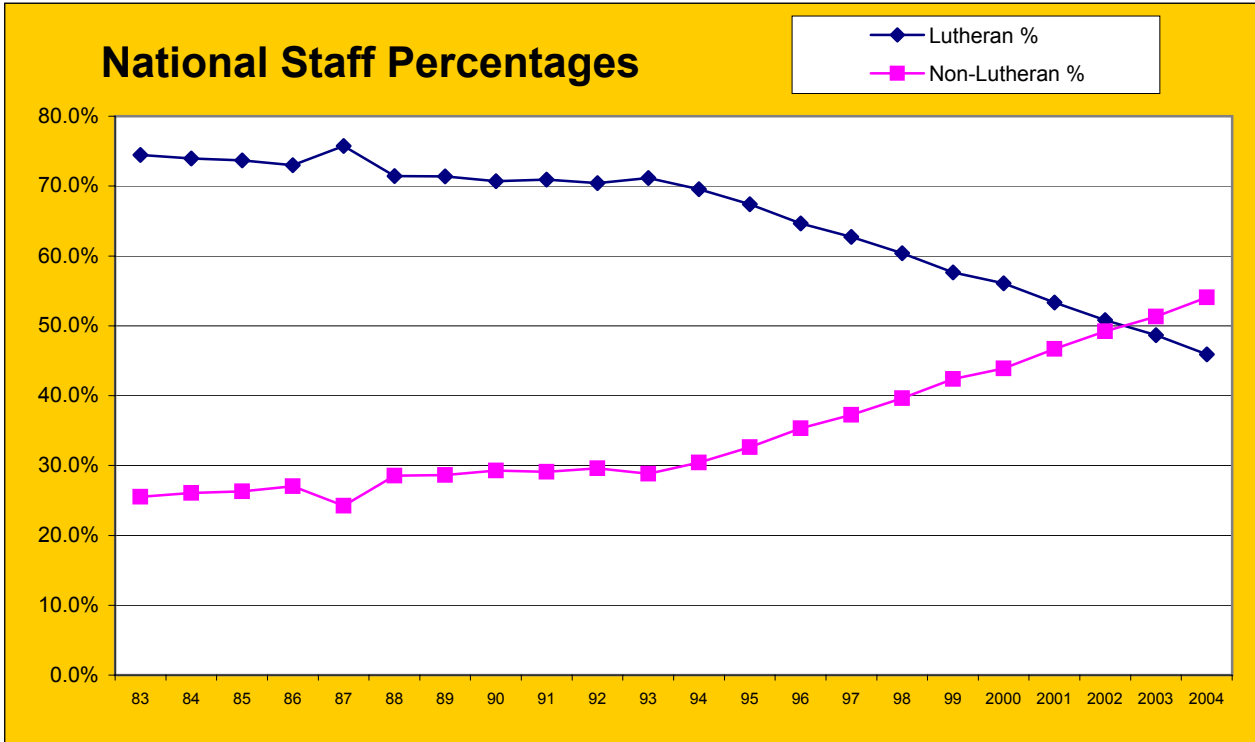
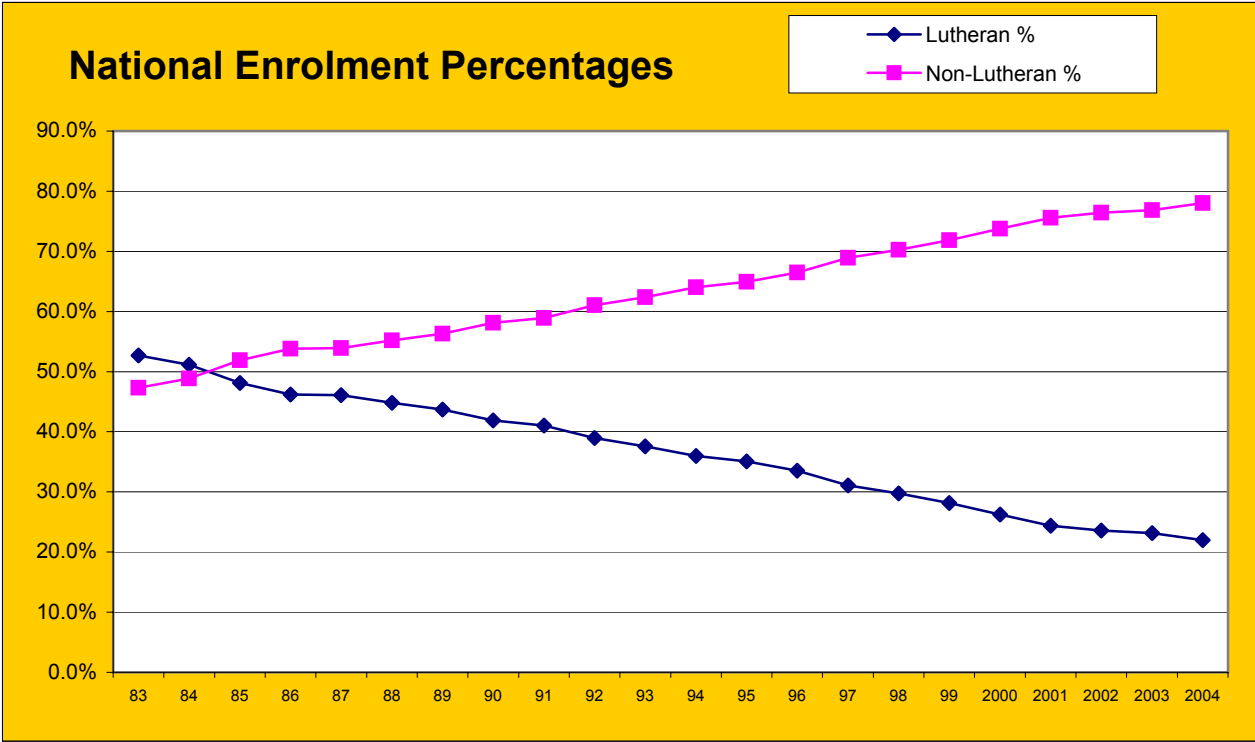


TRENDS Staff 1983 - 2004 by region

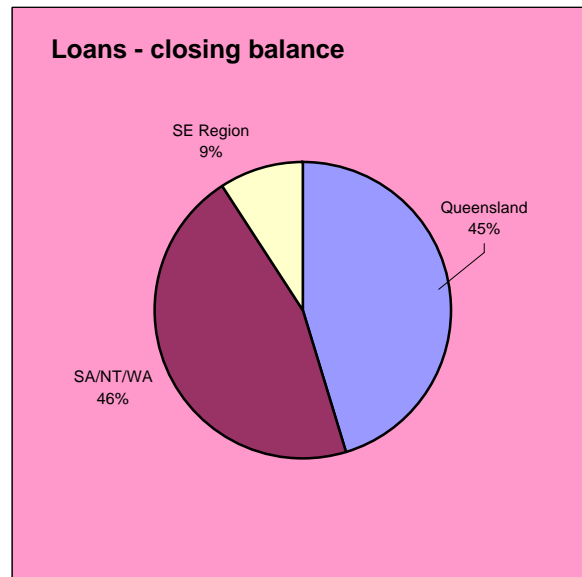
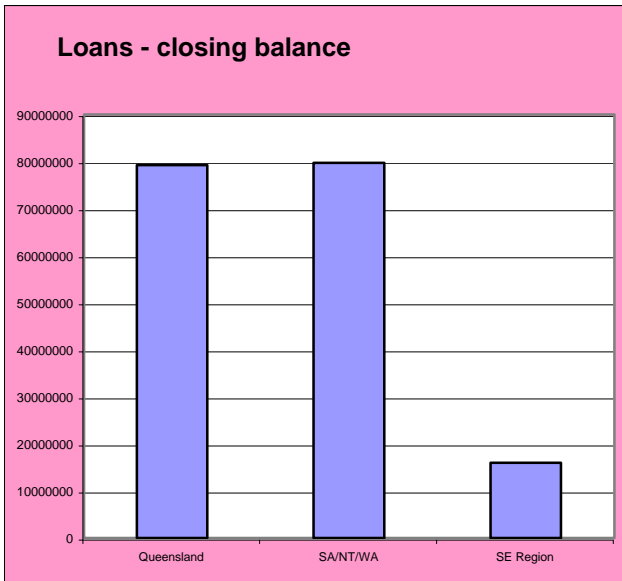
Financial Data as at 31 December 2003 (Recurrent)



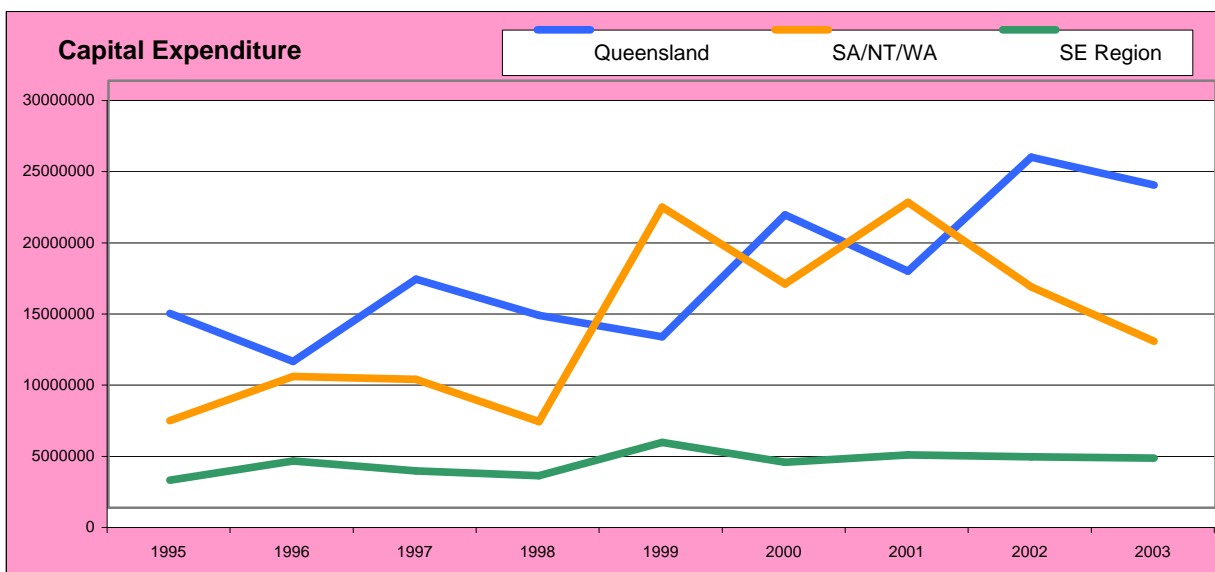
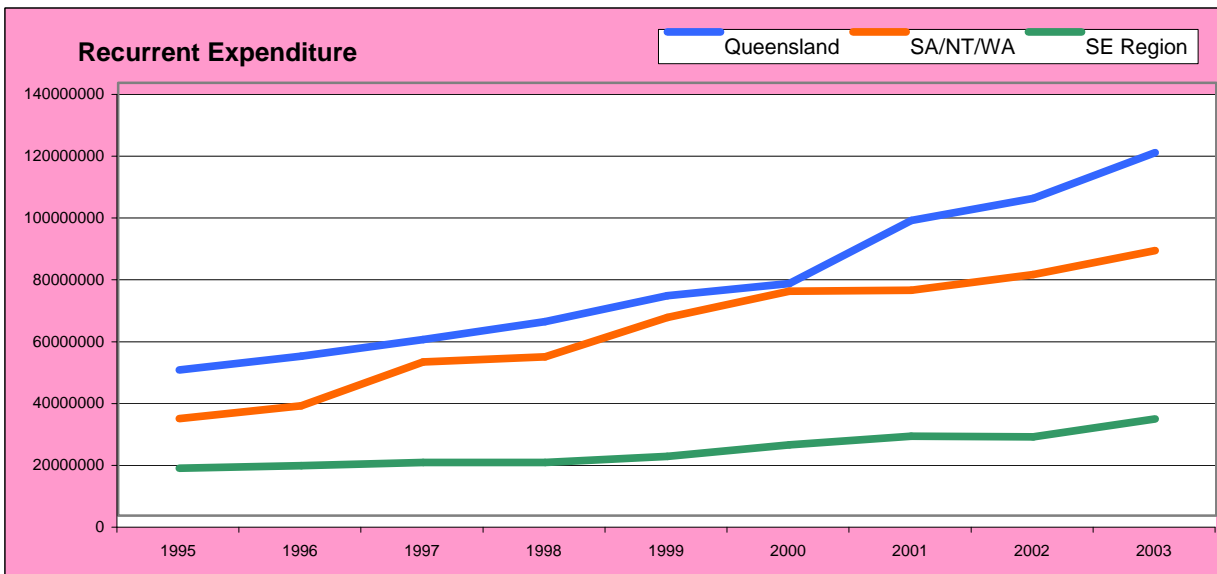
Financial Data as at 31 December 2003 (Capital purposes)



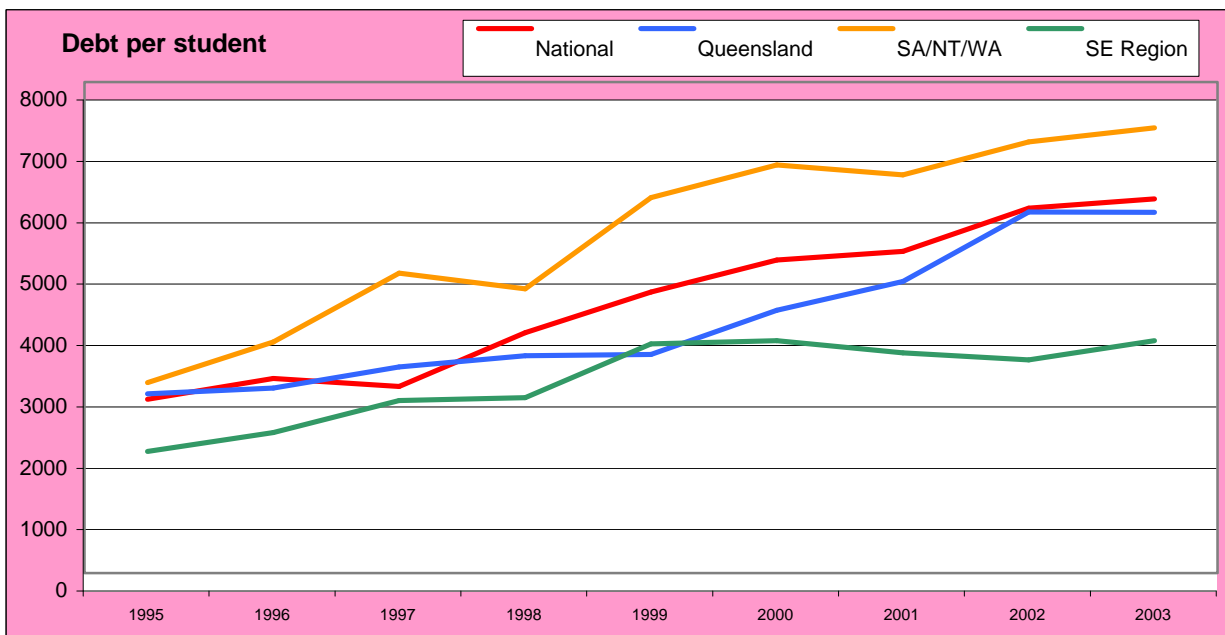
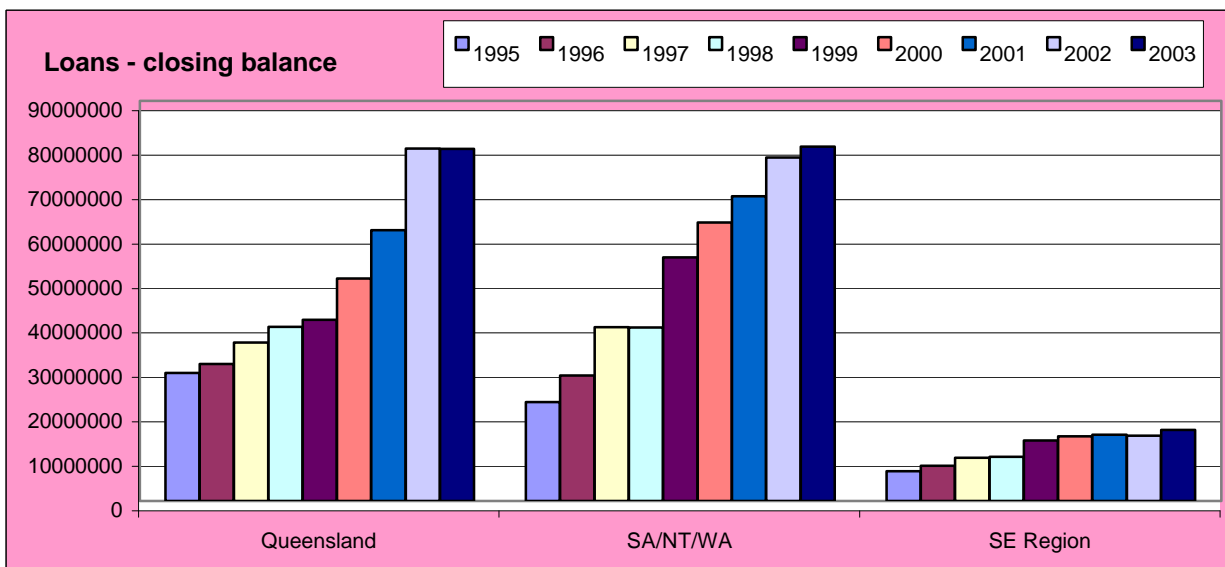
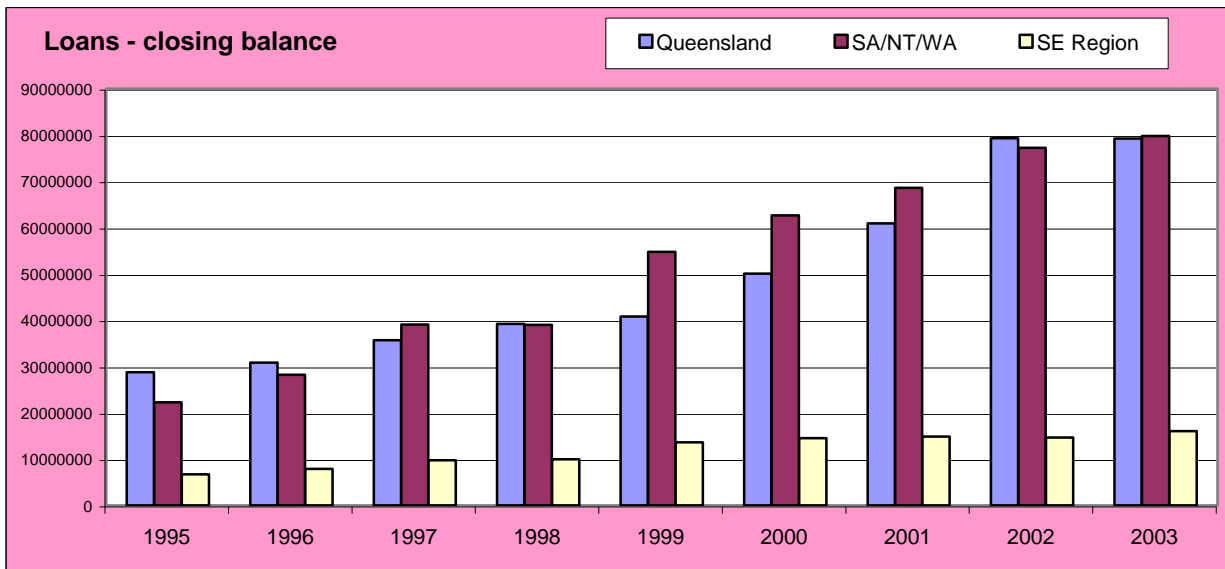
Financial Data as at 31 December 2003 (Loans)

Gender Statistics

In 2004 for a range of reasons, gender leadership data were not collected as per the agreed protocols. Accordingly, not all information was collected, and the collected data are not exactly comparable with previous years.

However, the quantum figures reported are accurate and are indicative of trends or lack of trends. The year of data has also been amended to the actual year in which data was collected.

The data indicate that the gains reported on in the 2003 report have been sustained. Gains in 2004 were modest. It is within reach to have a quarter of all principals female within LEA schools. In this context, it is encouraging that the percentage of females appointed continues to be above the mean.

What the report seems to be implying is that the matter of gender equity in leadership is one that requires ongoing vigilance.
