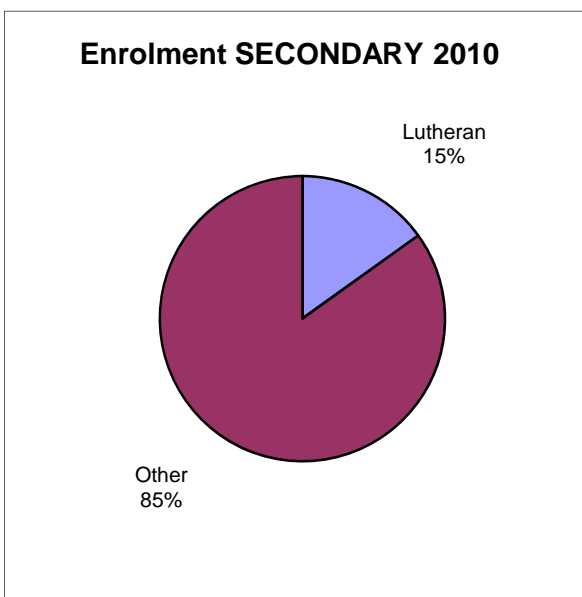
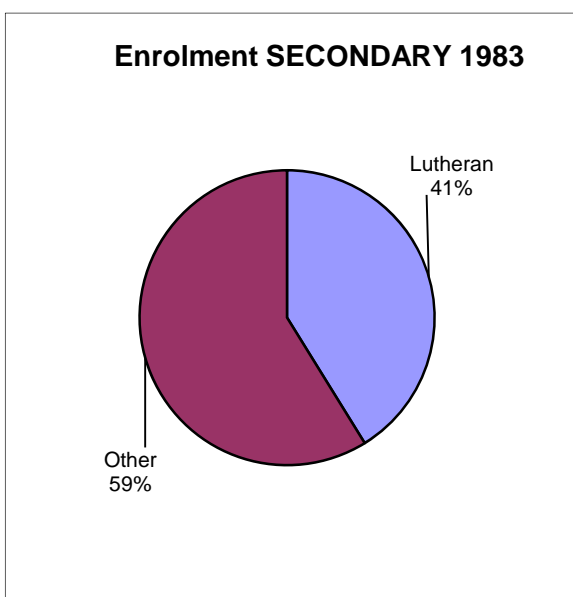
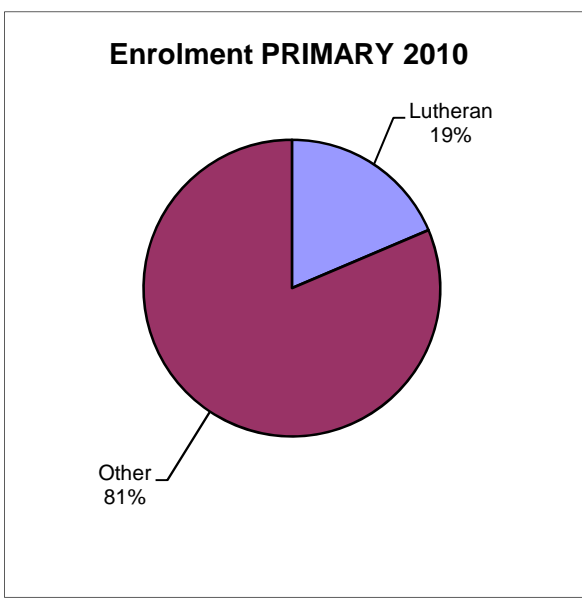
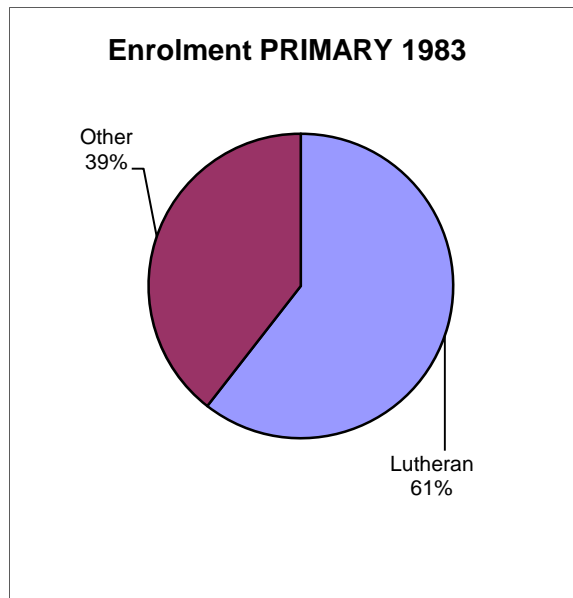
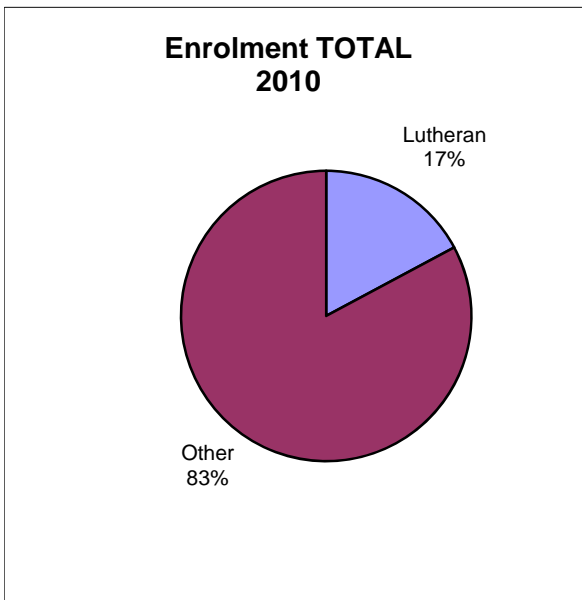
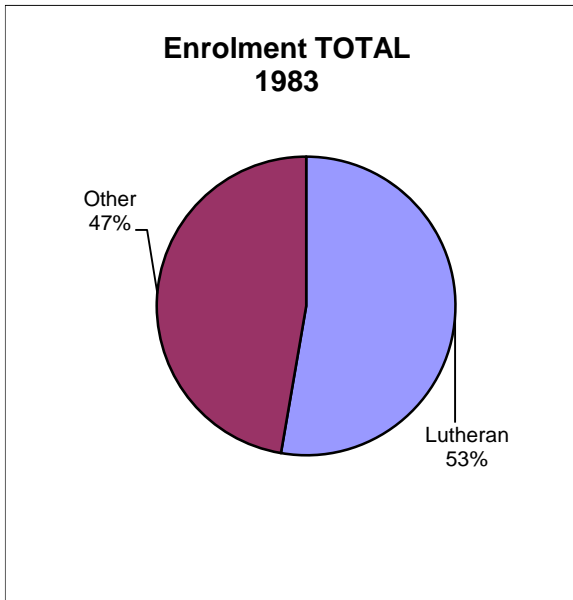
# TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2010 National



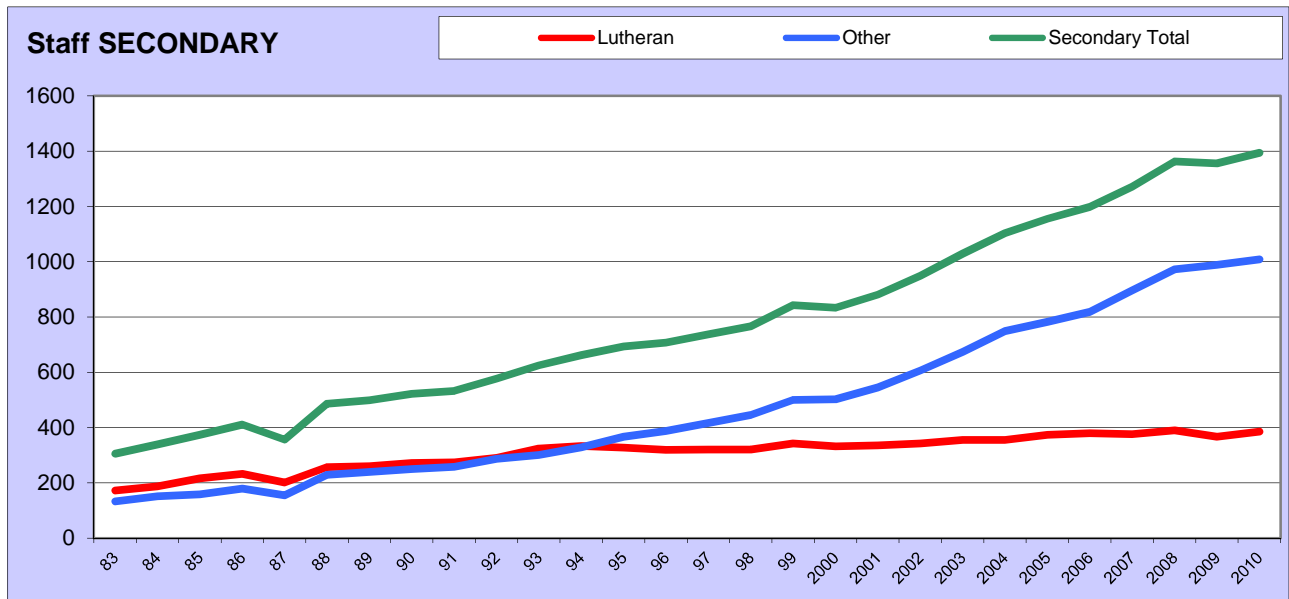
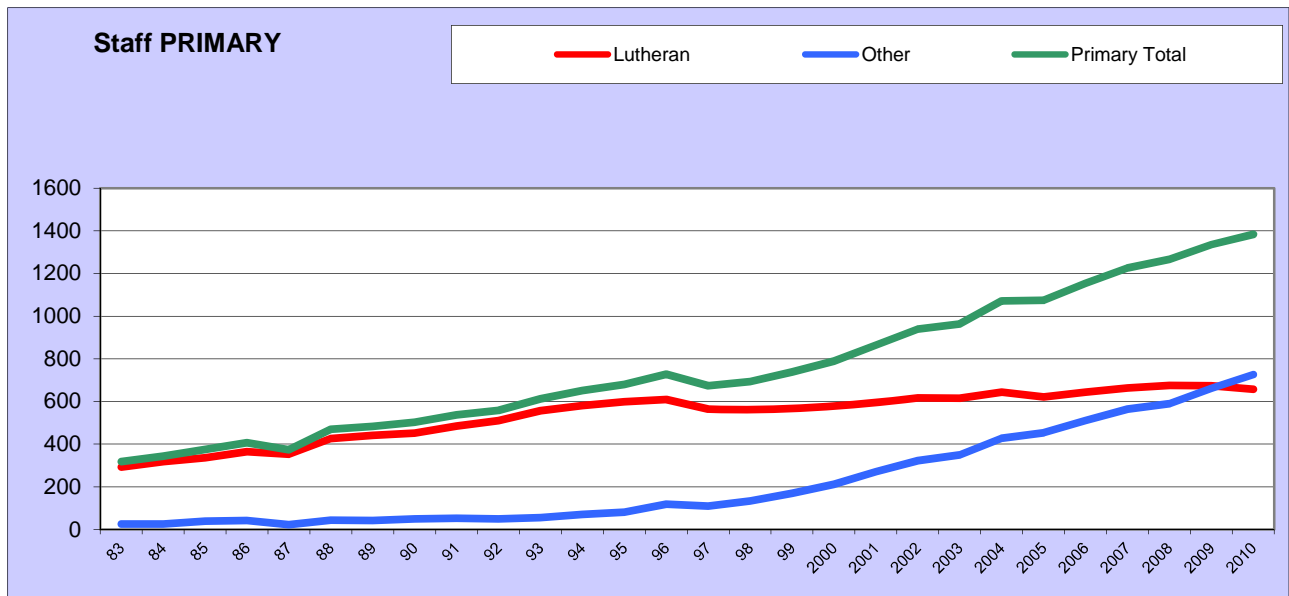
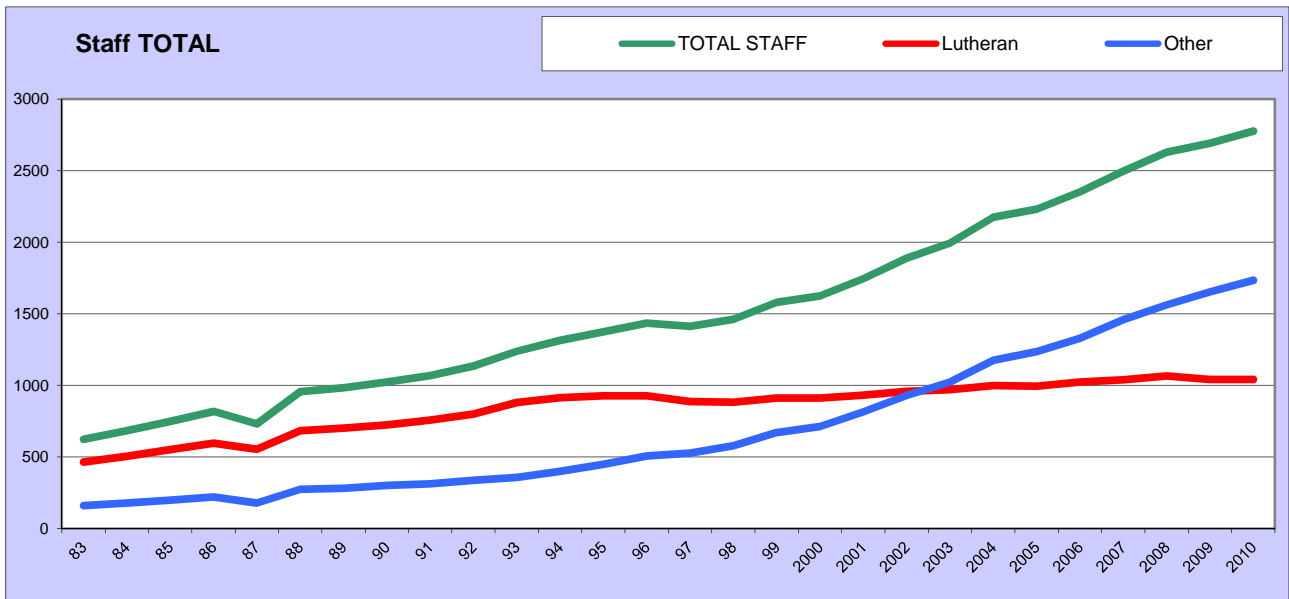
# TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2010 by region



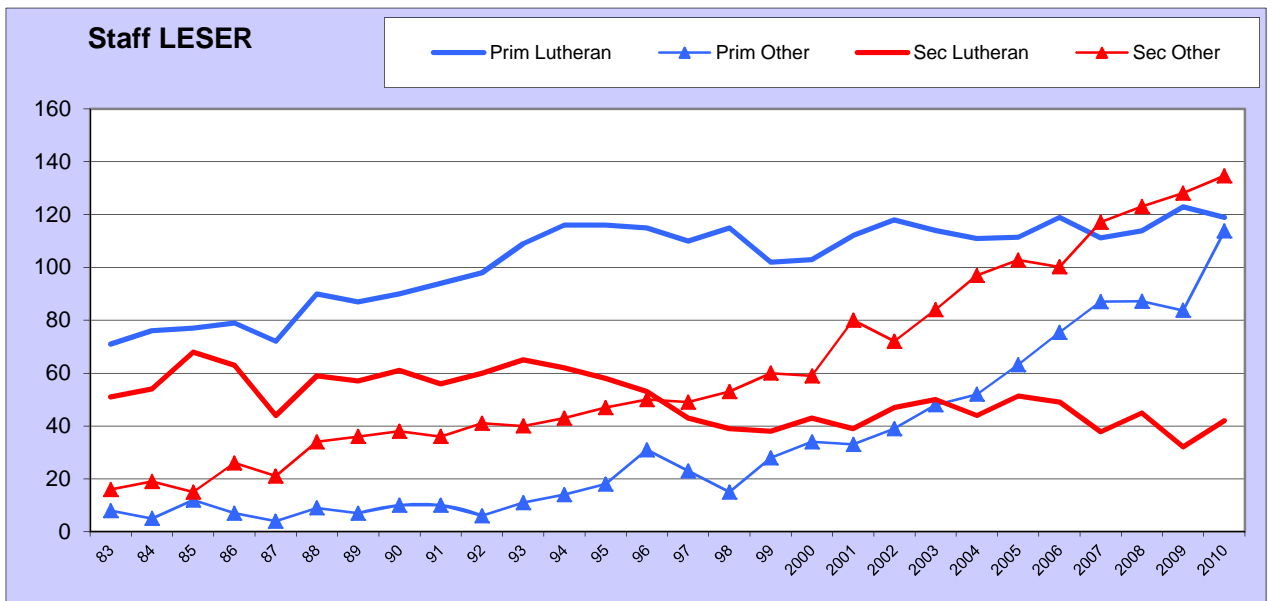
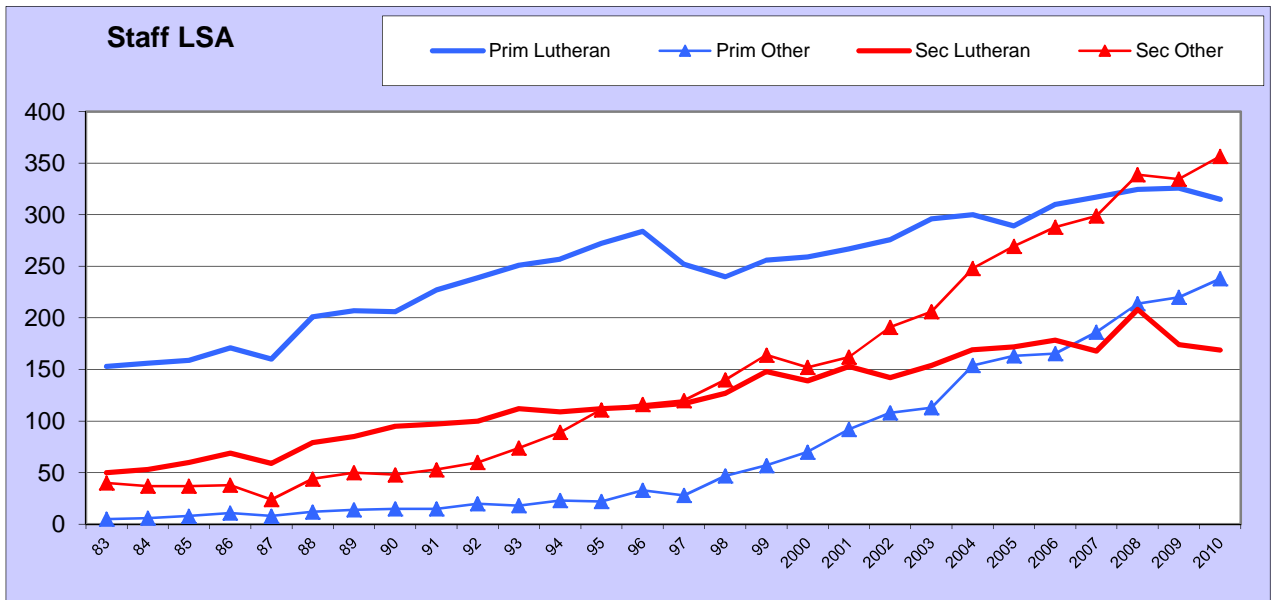
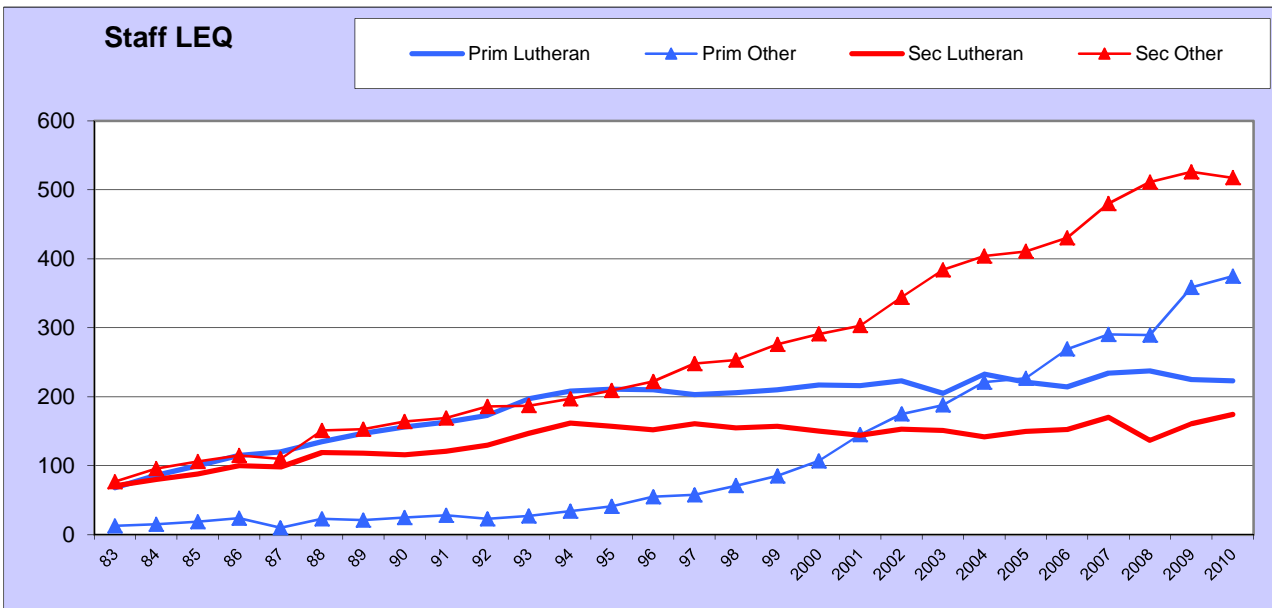

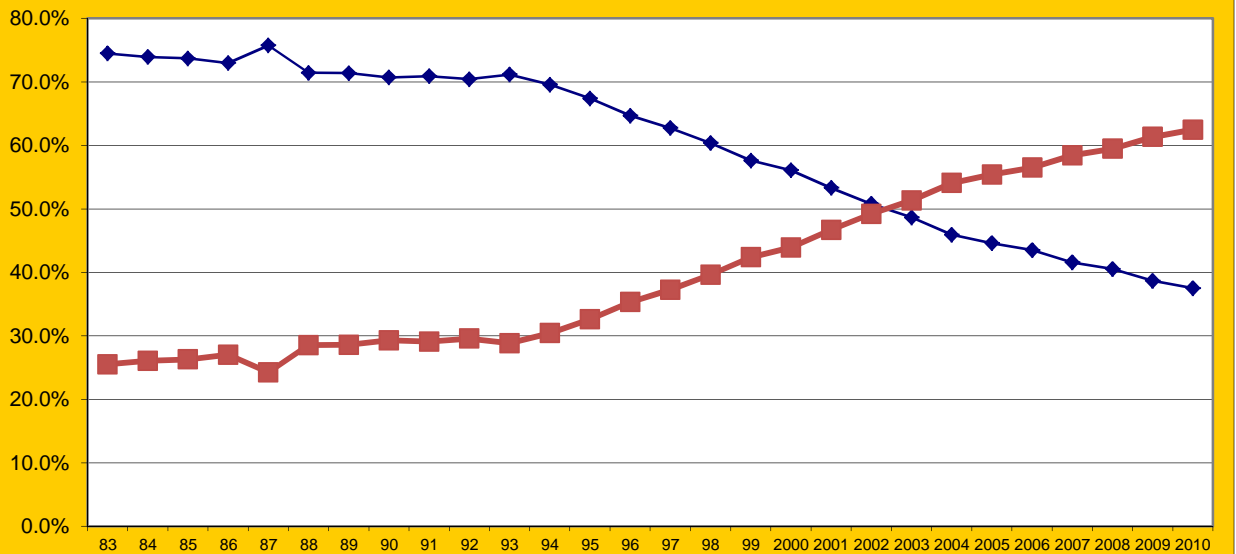




## National Enrolment Percentages



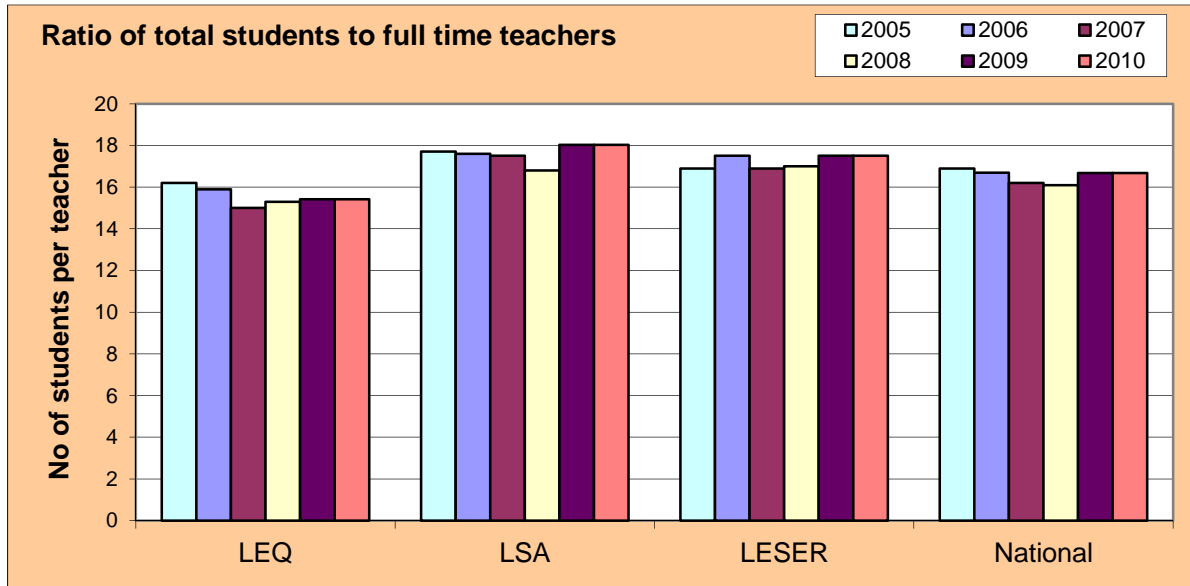

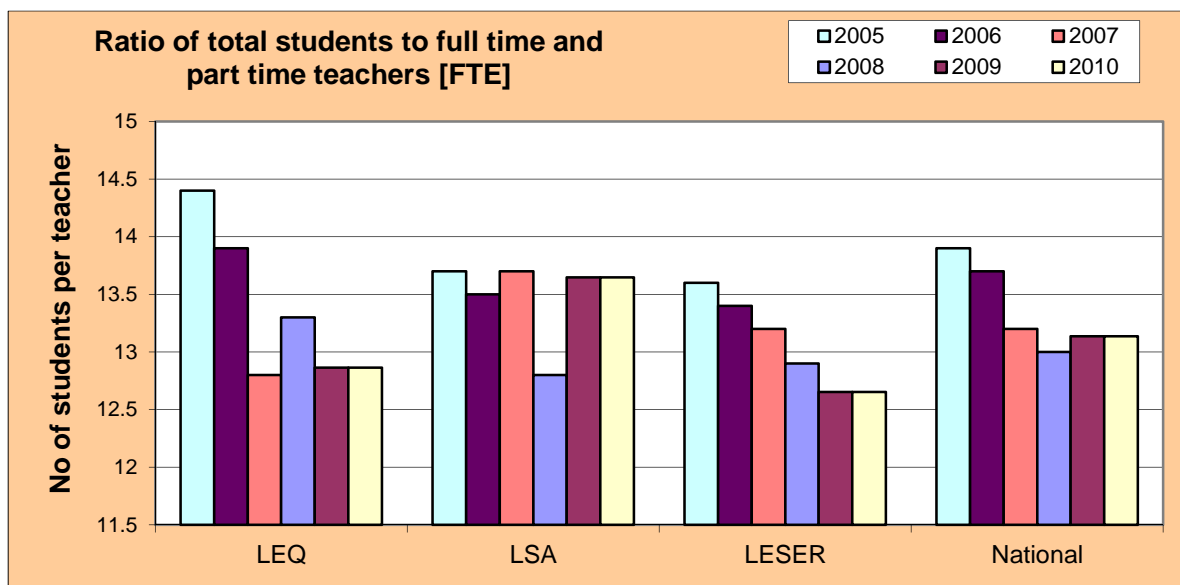

Ratio of students to full time and part time teachers [FTE]

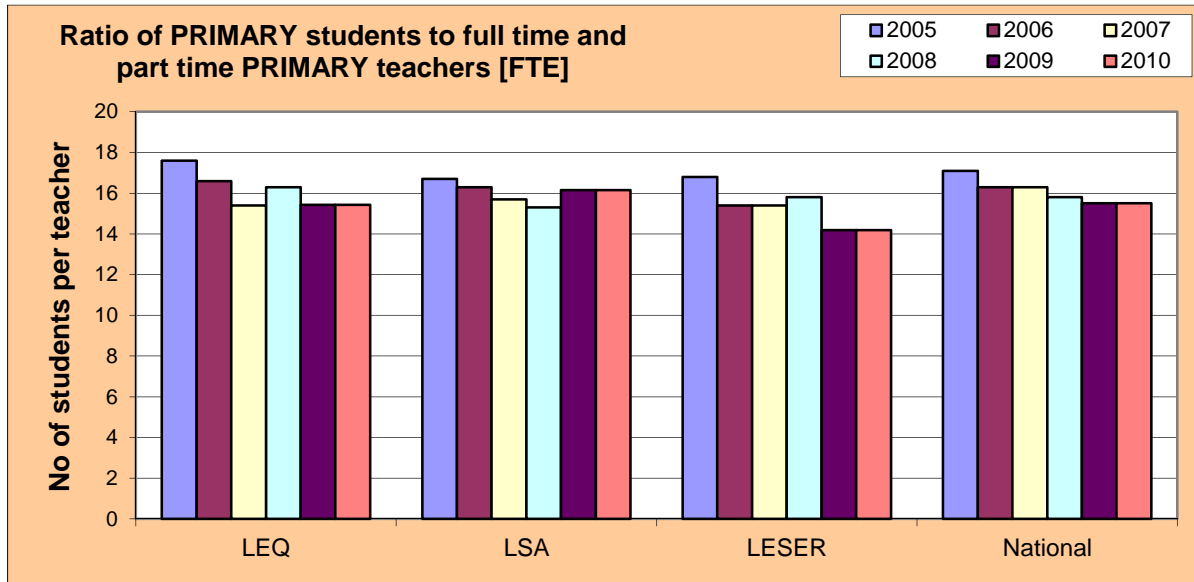

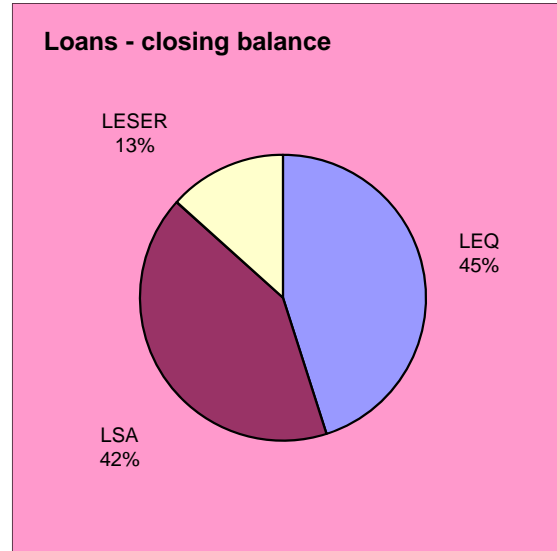
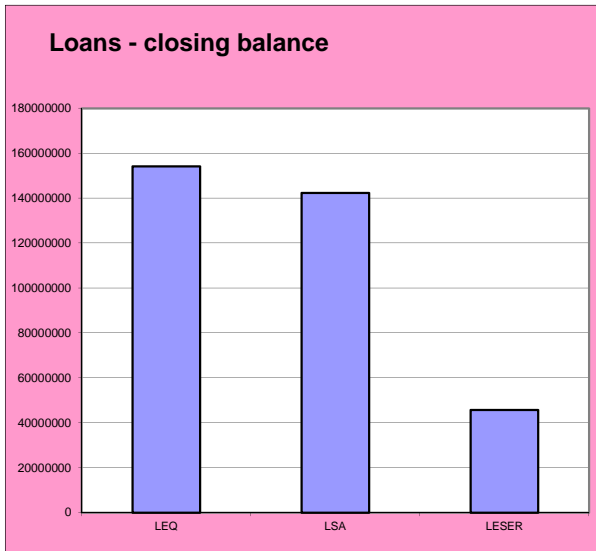
## Financial Data as at 31 December 2009 (Recurrent)



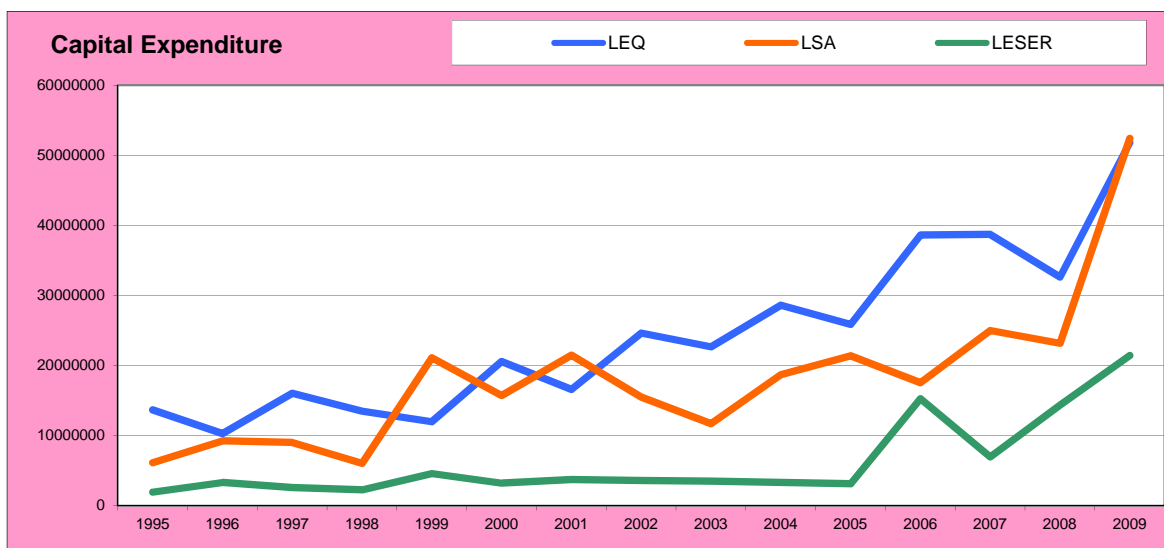
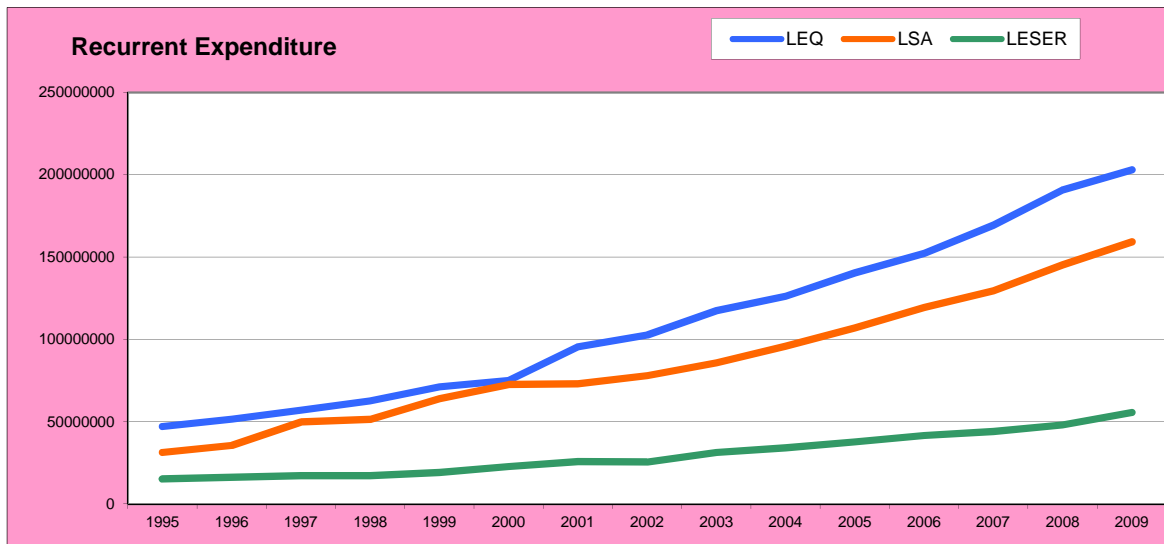
## Financial Data as at 31 December 2009 (Capital purposes)



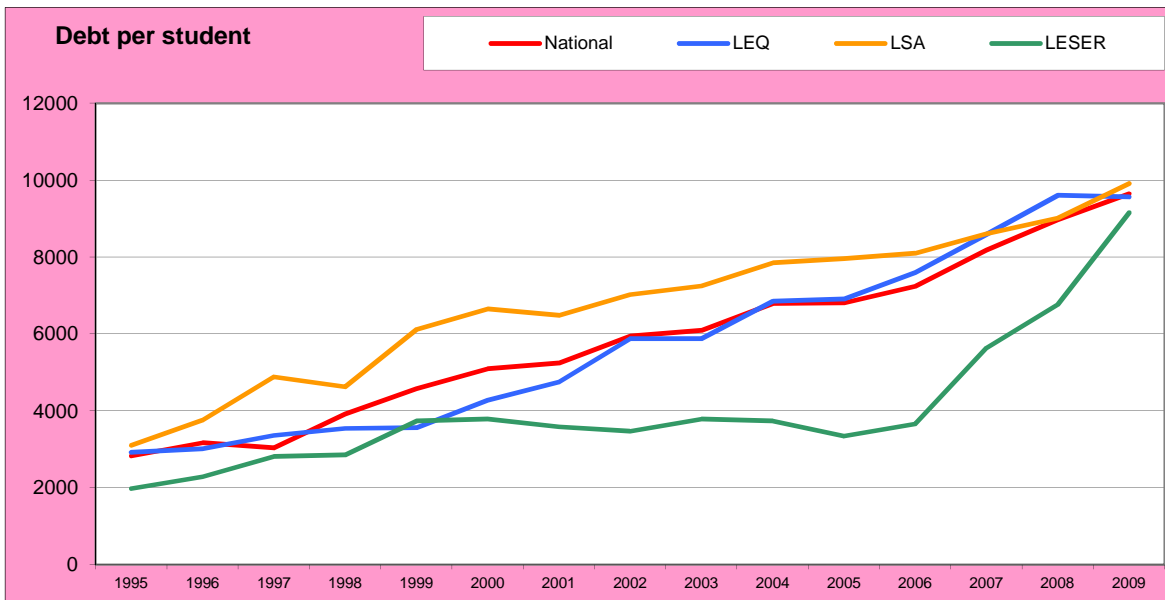
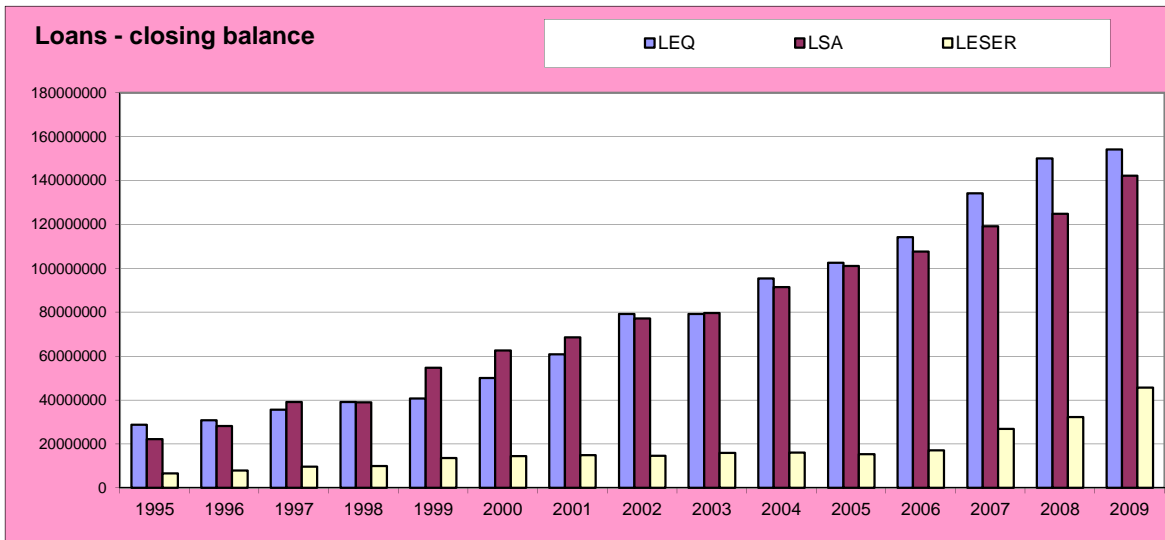
## Financial Data as at 31 December 2009 (Loans)
