



## **Teachers.on.net / LEA principal scholarship guidelines**

### **Introduction**

The Teachers.on.net / LEA scholarships are offered jointly by Teachers.on.net (TON) and Lutheran Education Australia (LEA). The scholarships have been set up to support rural and remote Lutheran principals in Australia to attend activities that may otherwise be financially prohibitive due to distance/remoteness. The TON/LEA scholarships will be offered for as long as TON and LEA are in a business relationship.

### **Objectives**

The key objectives of the scholarships are to provide financial assistance for principals from rural and remote Lutheran schools to attend a professional development activity.

It is expected that each recipient principal will provide a brief report to the LEA Executive Director. These reports may be used by Teachers.on.net and/or LEA for publicity purposes.

### **Suggested activities**

Examples of suggested activities may involve:

- LEA international tour
- National or international educational conference
- School visitations for specific learning project

### **Value**

TON will provide \$2,000 per annum and LEA will provide \$4,000 per annum to enable three scholarships, valued at \$2,000 each, to be offered annually. One scholarship will be available for a principal from each Lutheran school region. Each year the College of Directors will select/recommend one principal from a rural/remote school within their region as the recipient of their region's TON/LEA scholarship.

The scholarships will be awarded each year, and funds must be utilised by the three nominated schools during the next calendar year. Applications must be made to the LEA Assistant Director: Leadership by 1<sup>st</sup> February. The scholarships will be awarded by mid February 2015.

The respective Regional Director will support their nominated principal in the selection of the specific activity/ies to be funded.

### **Eligibility**

To be eligible for the Teachers.on.net / LEA principal scholarship the applicant must hold the position of principal of a rural and remote Lutheran school. Rural and remote may be defined as being a Lutheran school 100 Km or more from Adelaide, Brisbane or Melbourne.
