She has co-led students from Pacific on International study and service learning trips and she is pioneering diverse ways to develop authentic intercultural understanding.

TIME: Single session in the ACLE program

ABSTRACT:

An internationalised curriculum is important in helping our students to wise up and transform their minds so that they may participate in a globalised workforce and engage meaningfully and positively with diverse cultures. This session examines key aspects of Internationalisation. Karen will draw upon her experiences both as an accountant and as a teacher to share insights that she has gleaned through her dual careers. Karen is also keen to listen to others who have encountered/are keen to develop internationalisation as part of their school culture. She intends to workshop with other participants to build a better picture of what Internationalisation could look like in a Lutheran School setting – and to explore how Internationalisation links to other overseas-focussed projects in schools.
