Wise-Up and get with IT!

A presentation on building learning pathways or multimedia workflows that integrate photos, "Explain Everything" and Aurasma to create animations that come to life (and integrate with Yr 5 Science) – Primary focus.

Method of delivery: Presenter will give demonstration and then workshop with teachers to develop similar workflows.

A description of the issue or problem to be solved

How do I make Yr 5 Science interesting and motivating? What can we do to inspire our students and help them develop an understanding for how and why animals adapt to their environments?

A description of why the audience should care for the issue

This presentation brings the magic back into teaching, Students are motivated by the sudden appearance of their videos when the iPad is moved over the target image.

Approach used to solve it

The presenter will discuss traditional methods of teaching the topic and then demonstrate a multimedia workflow using iPads, camera roll, Google images, Explain Everything and Aurasma.

Possible results or outcomes of the approach

The approach is driven by the SAMR model and identifies with the top levels of the model. Student engagement and outcomes have been shown to be much higher than with the traditional approach.

How this presentation links to theme/s of the conference

This presentation discusses the two focus Questions:

- What shapes quality education in a Lutheran school?

- What 21st technologies will meet the aims of Lutheran schooling?

It looks at creating learning pathways that lead to quality education using 21st century approaches to learning.
