## For services to Lutheran schooling 1983 - 2019

Helane commenced her service in Lutheran Schools in 1983 where she served as a year three teacher at Good Shepherd Lutheran School Para Vista. Helane resigned from her teaching position in June 1985 to have her family.

In the years between 1985 and 2000 Helane served as a regular relief teacher, always ready for those early morning calls, responding whenever she could. Helane also completed a number of contracts, working some part of each year through out this time. Helane also served with dedication and passion on the school council at Good Shepherd for 9 years.

In 2000, Helane returned to Good Shepherd in a part time capacity where the majority of this time she provided Visual Art lessons across the school. Her passion and drive for this area of the curriculum never waned. Helane inspired many students over the years with her love of the Arts
