## For services to Lutheran schooling 1994 – 2019

The Lutheran Church of Australia thankfully acknowledges the faithful and committed service of Rhonda Myers for 25 years.

Rhonda commenced her service in Lutheran education in 1994 when she was appointed as a Teacher Assistant at Grace Lutheran College, Rothwell Qld. In 2007 Rhonda took on the role of Deputy Principal's Administration Assistant, a position she held until her retirement in 2019. For a short time (November 2006 to February 2007) Rhonda was the Acting Headmaster's Secretary.

Rhonda has demonstrated commitment and dedication to Grace Lutheran College both as a parent and as a long serving staff member. Her voluntary role on the Parents and Friends Committee allowed her to engage, and build lasting relationships, with many parents with a common goal of serving the Grace community.
