## **Beryl Paech**

## For services to Lutheran schooling 1978-1980 and 1997-2017

The Lutheran Church of Australia thankfully acknowledges the faithful and committed service of Beryl Paech to Lutheran education for 24 years.

Beryl commenced her service in Lutheran schools when she joined the staff at Immanuel Lutheran School, Gawler SA in 1978. In 1980 she moved to Queensland and took up a position at Immanuel Lutheran College, Maroochydore, where she taught for one year. In 1997 Beryl joined the staff at Grace Lutheran College, Rothwell, as part of the administration team.

At Grace, Beryl served as the first Learning Support Teacher Aide. She initially began supporting students with their academic tasks, but as the years progressed, it became evident that Beryl's ability to plan and organise the department and create a tight knit team of colleagues was invaluable, and so she became the Administrative Assistant to the ever growing number of staff in Learning Support.

During her time out of schools, Beryl's Christian service continued as she ran playgroups, women's groups and coordinated *kids clubs* in Port Lincoln and Victor Harbor. Additionally, Beryl's dedication to her local congregations and the support she provided many people has been unmeasurable.
