

Graduate Certificate in Education and Theology (GCET) Course Structure

A University of Divinity (UD) graduate certificate is 72 points (the equivalent of one full time semester)

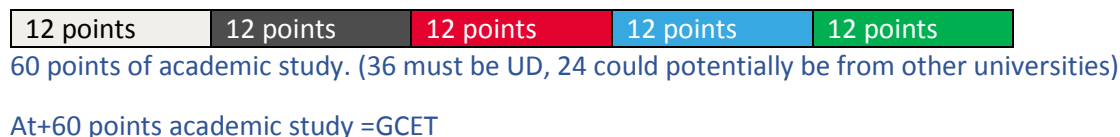
It is suggested that potential participants conceptualise the award in 12 point blocks. Each 12 points is roughly the equivalent of 100 hours and 3,000-3,500 words of assessment. (A standard UD post graduate unit is 24 points, half units are suggested to enable more choice and to make the study load more manageable. Participants can undertake more than one in a single semester if they wish)



Possible Routes through the certificate

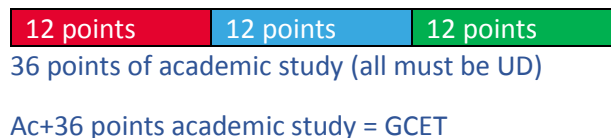
Route 1 (for non CS teachers, ALC preservice graduates and chaplains who don't teach CS)

At (Accreditation-teacher)

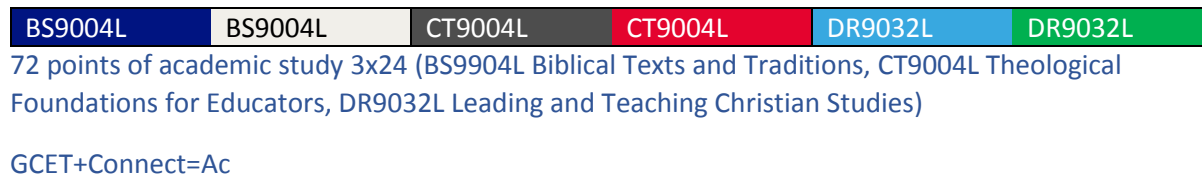


Route 2 (for CS teachers)
