

Examples of focus for the ePortfolio in *Connect*

1. Analyse and critically reflect on how a Lutheran theological concept shapes the practice of Lutheran education. Explain and justify implications for your role in the school or early childhood service, eg, investigate the implications of creation theology for learning in your ECS or class, implications of the concept of grace for the development of identity and spirituality of students.
2. Choose a specific area of practice (eg, behaviour management, teaching and learning, pastoral care) and inquire into the Lutheran theological perspectives (professional conversations, readings, videos) that provide insights and inform practice in the school or ECS. Explain and justify implications for your role in the school or early childhood service.
3. Lutheran education describes ongoing improvement and innovation as a key Vocational practice. Conduct research into an aspect of Christian education at your school or ECS to analyse areas of strength and improvement. Inquire into the theology (professional conversations, readings) that informs this aspect of Christian education. Critically reflect on your findings to consider the implications and ways forward for your school or ECS community.
