For services to Lutheran schooling 1988 – 2018

Julie's service to Lutheran education commenced in 1988 when she joined the staff of Concordia Primary School, Toowoomba Qld, as a classroom and music teacher. In 2008 when Concordia Primary School amalgamated with Concordia Lutheran College, Julie was appointed Acting Head of Campus and in 2009 Director of Campus for Concordia Primary which is now known as Warwick Street Campus. She served continuously in this role until her retirement at the end of 2018.

Julie was educated at Concordia Primary and Concordia College. She developed a strong servant leadership style passionately focused on sharing in the mission and ministry of the church.
