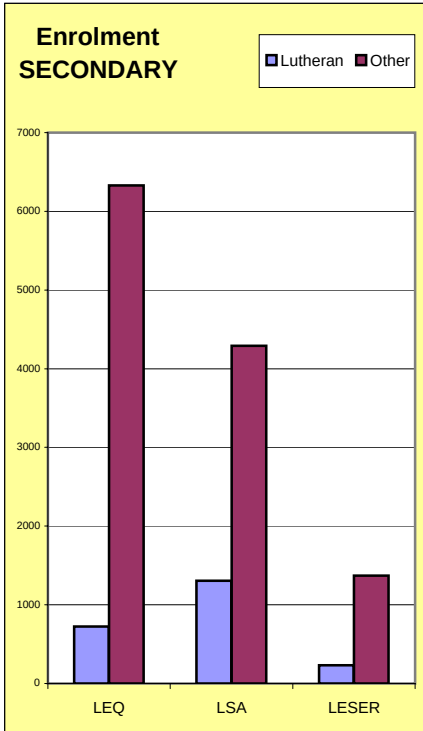
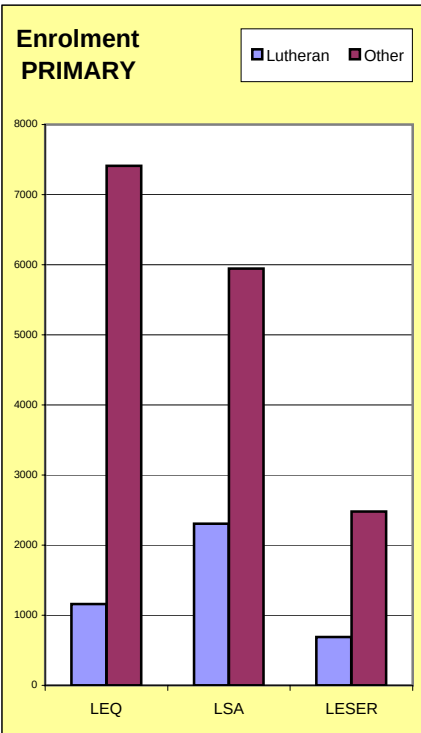
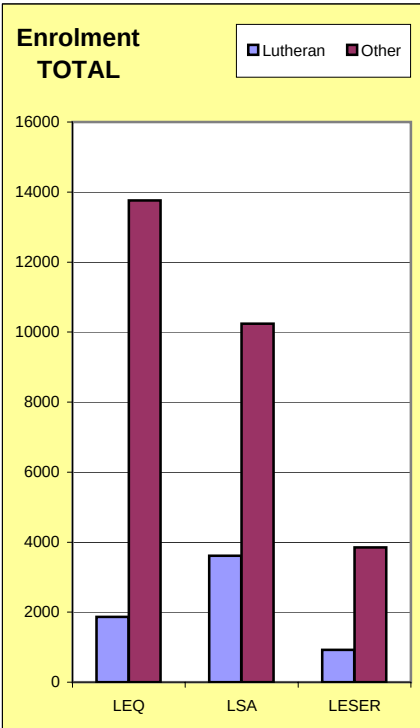
Enrolment by region



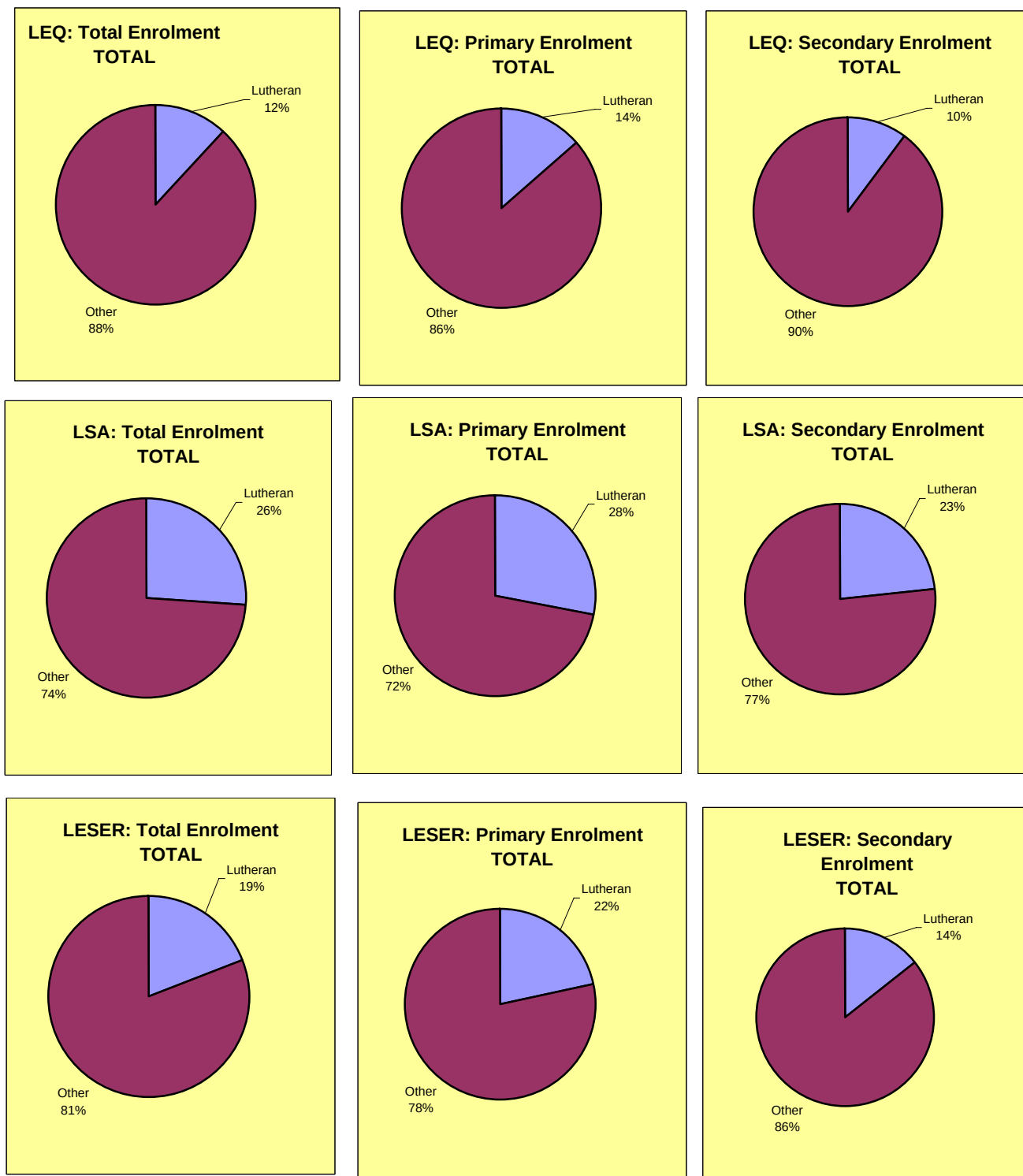

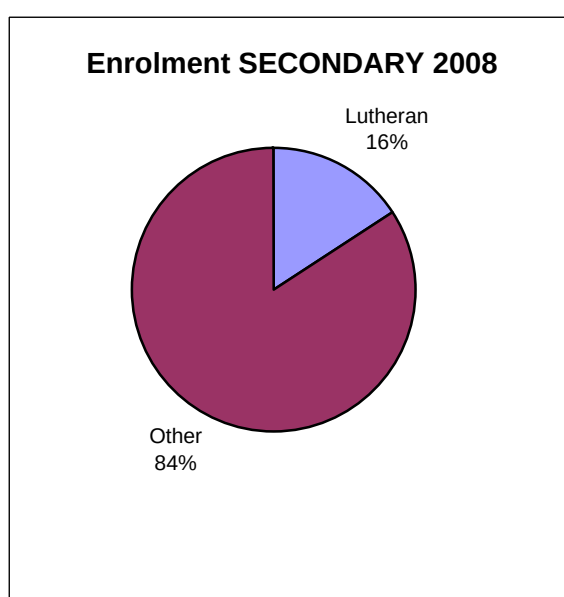
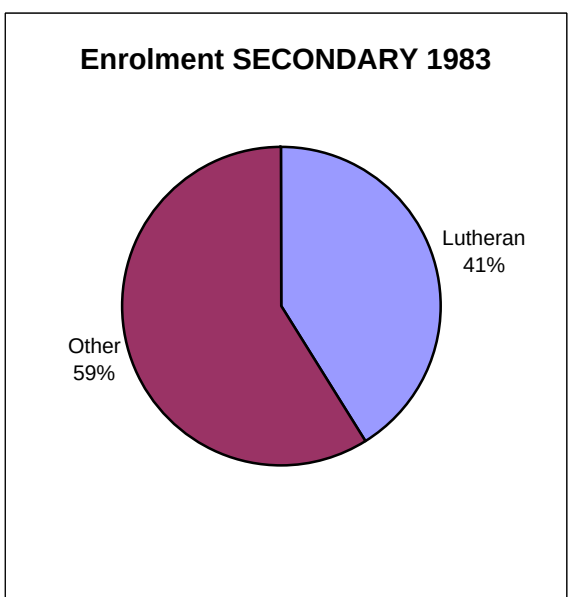
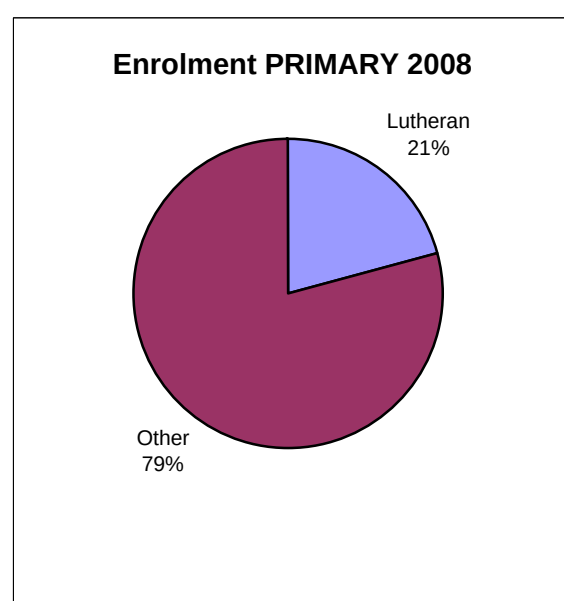
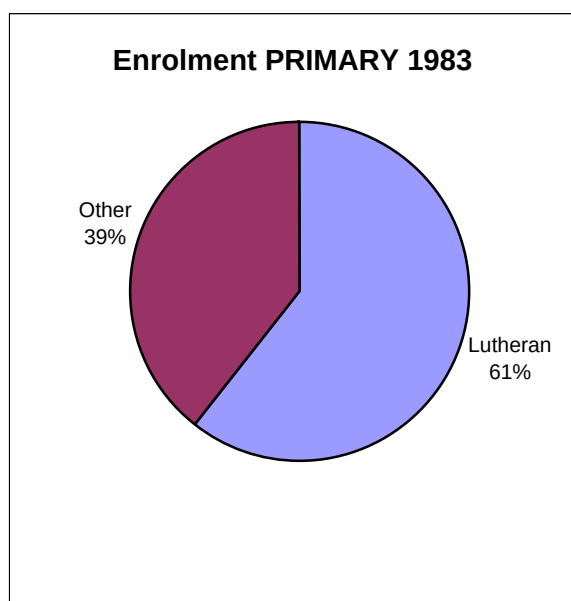
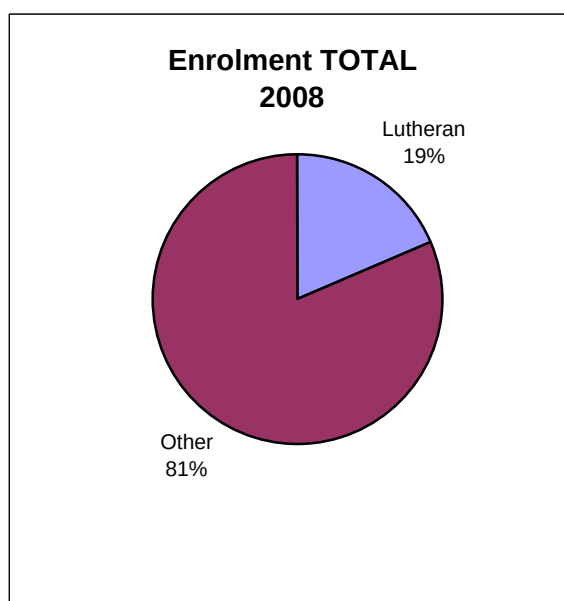
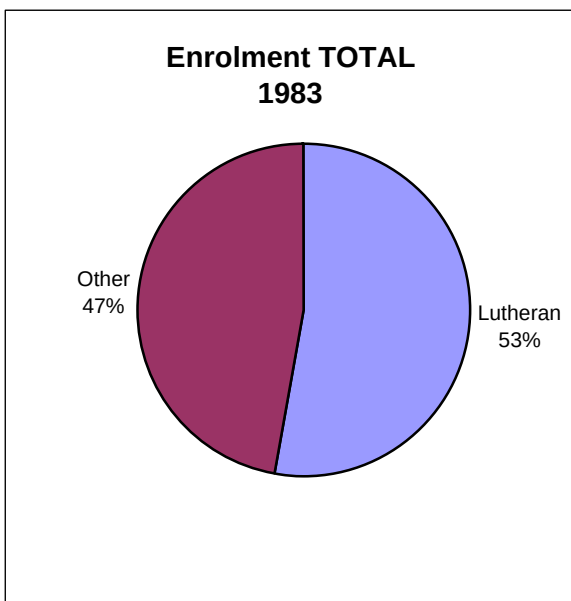
TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2008 National



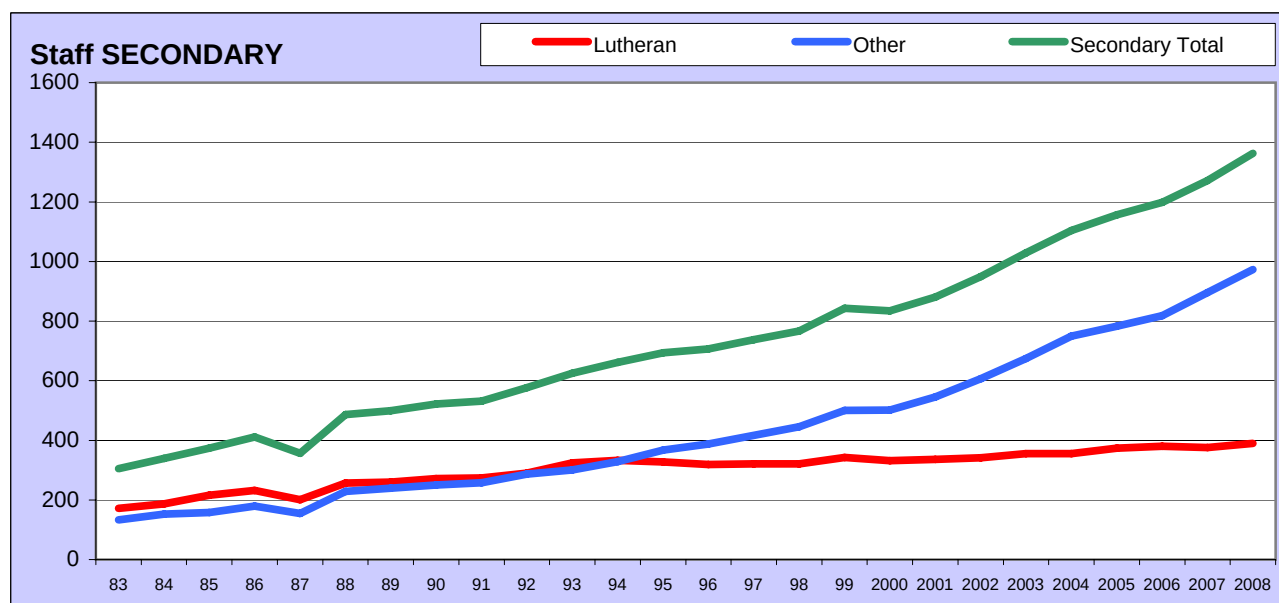
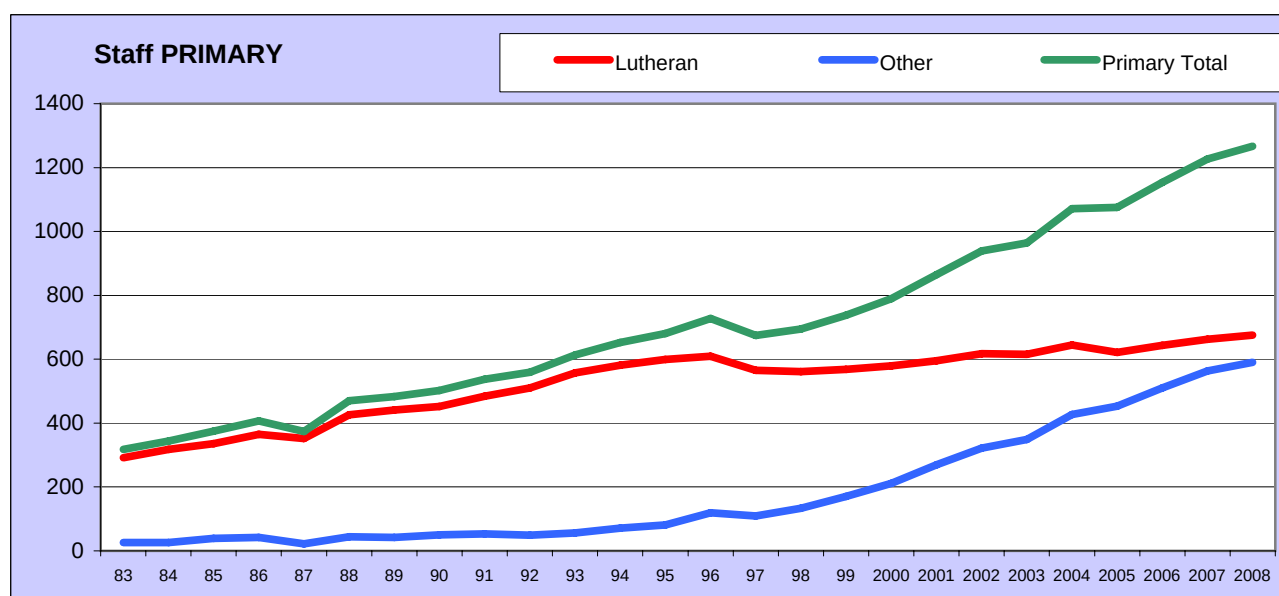
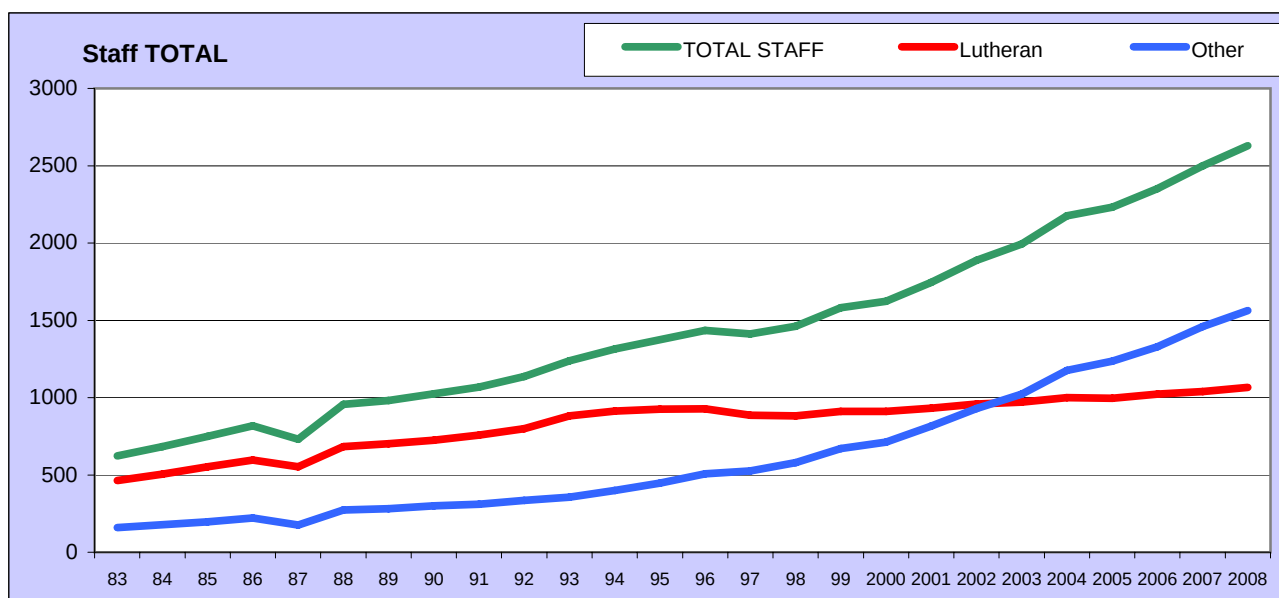
TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2008 by region



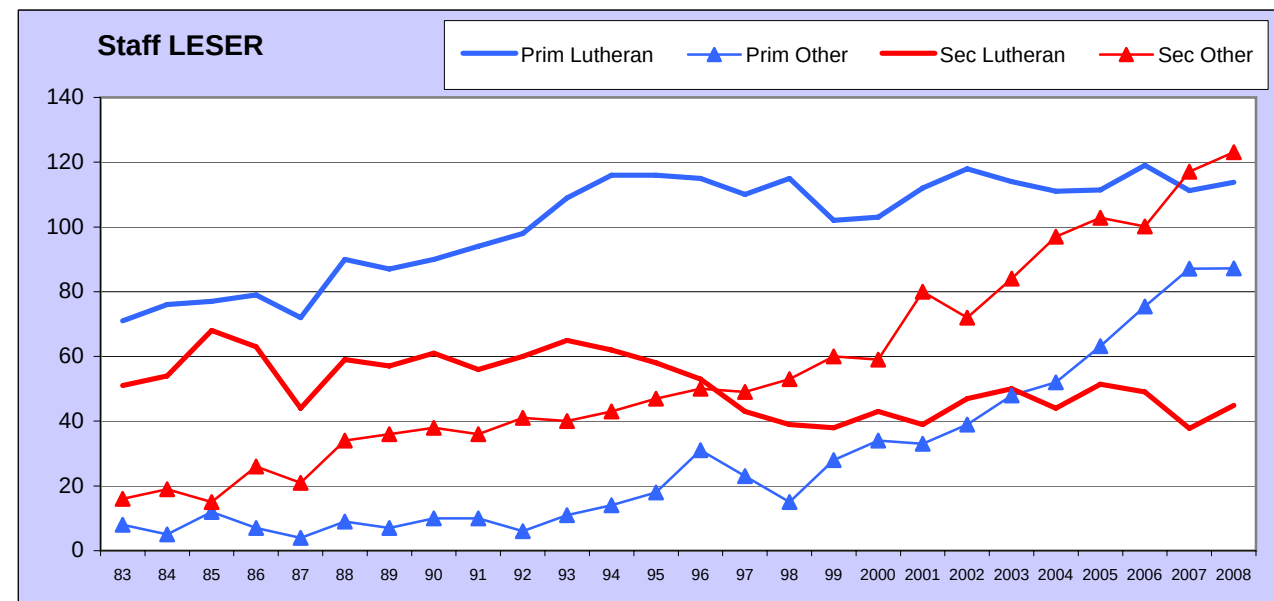
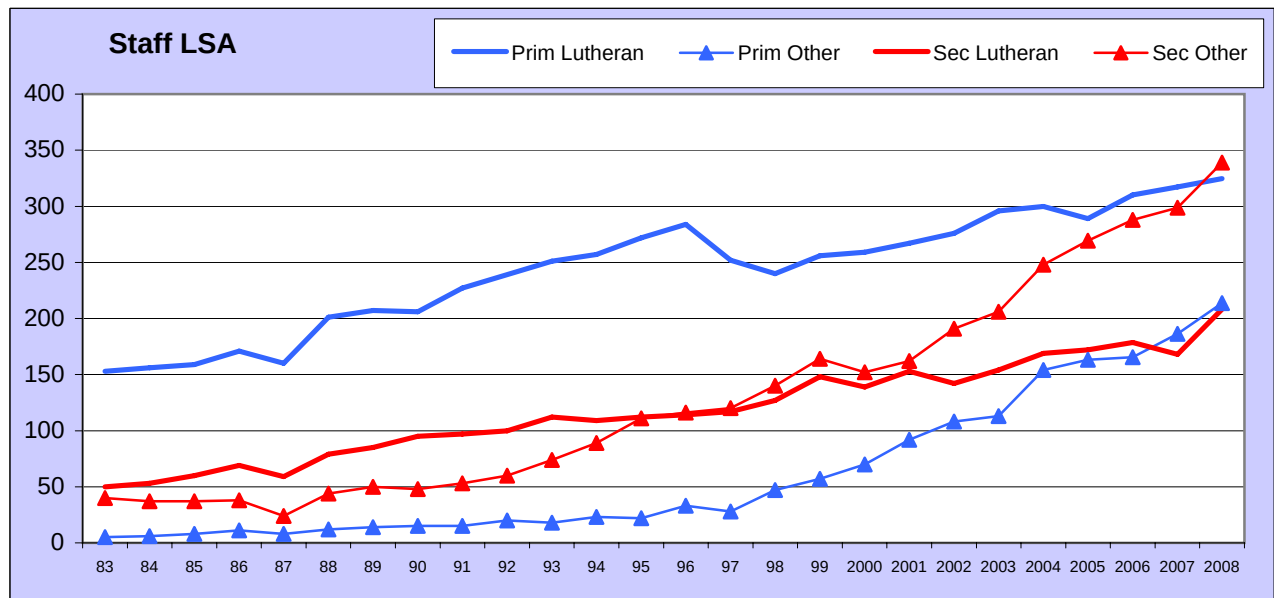
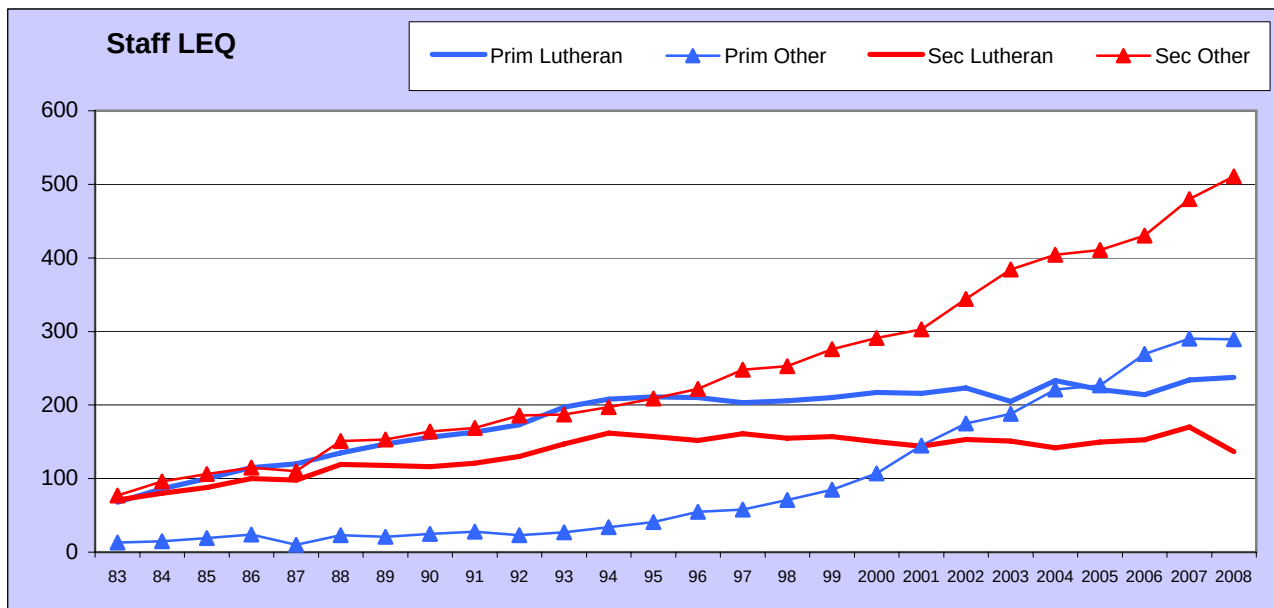

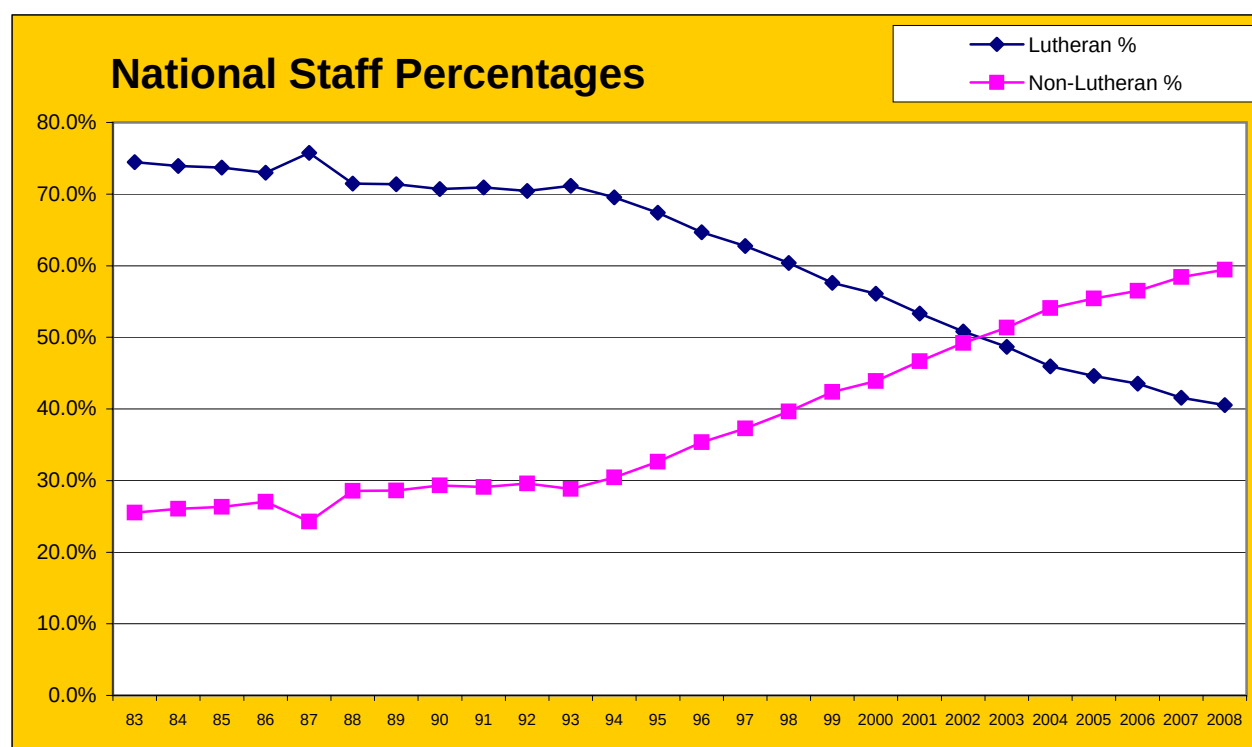
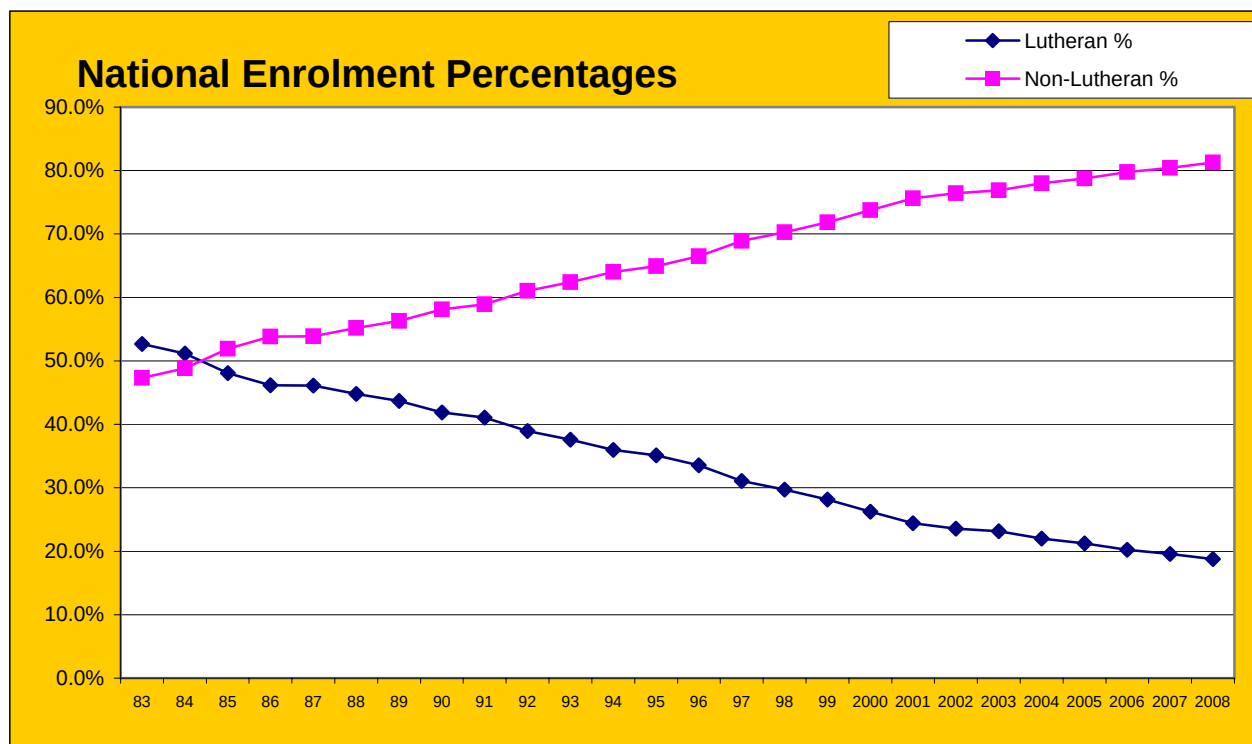


TRENDS Staff 1983 - 2008 by region

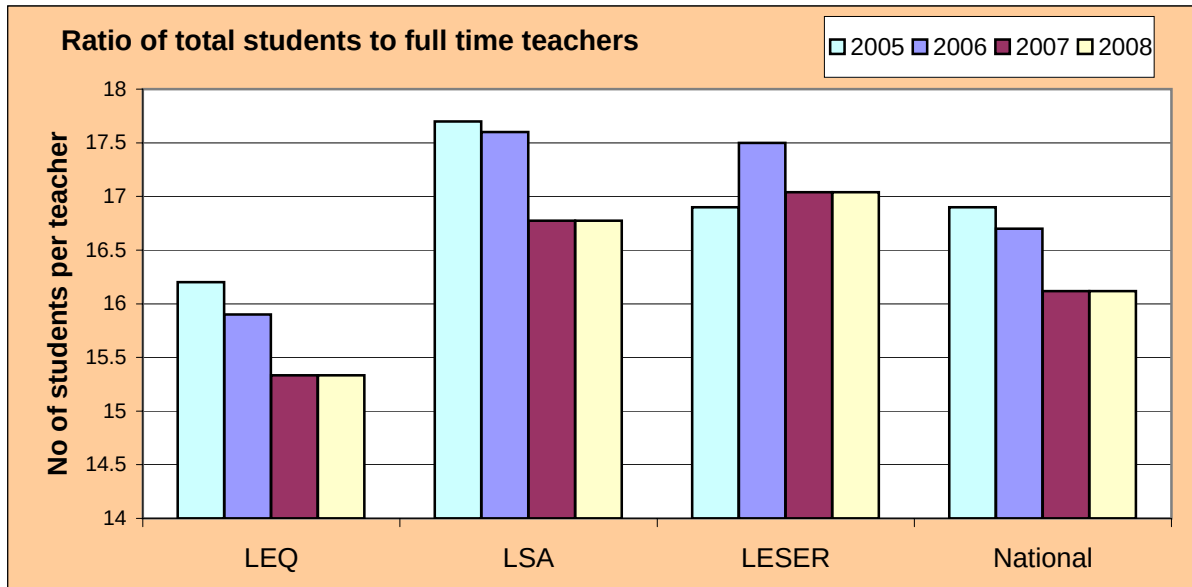

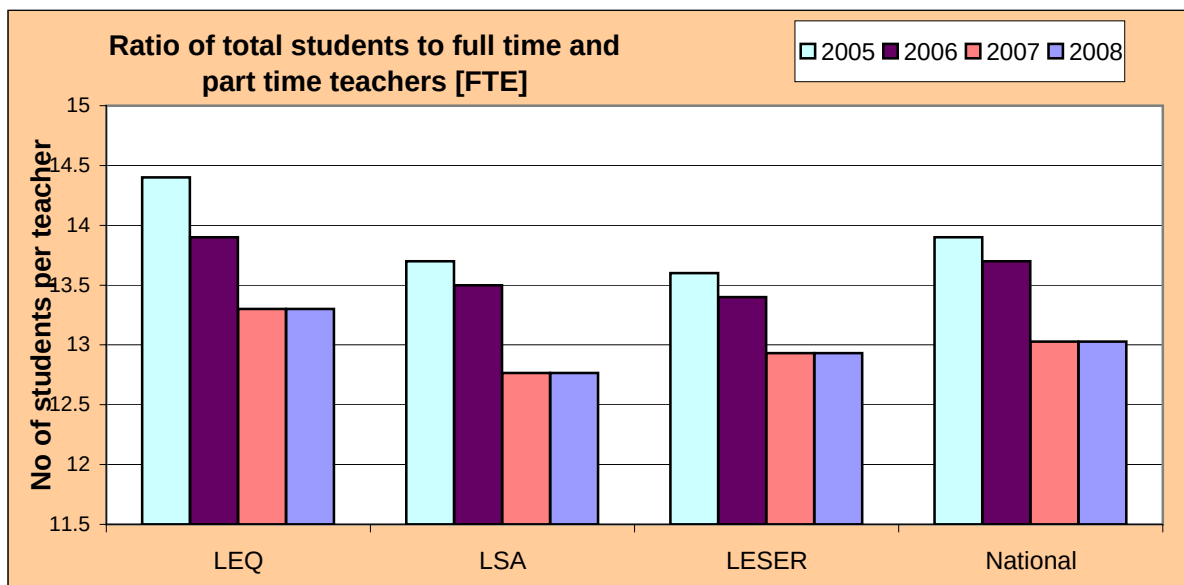

Ratio of students to full time and part time teachers [FTE]

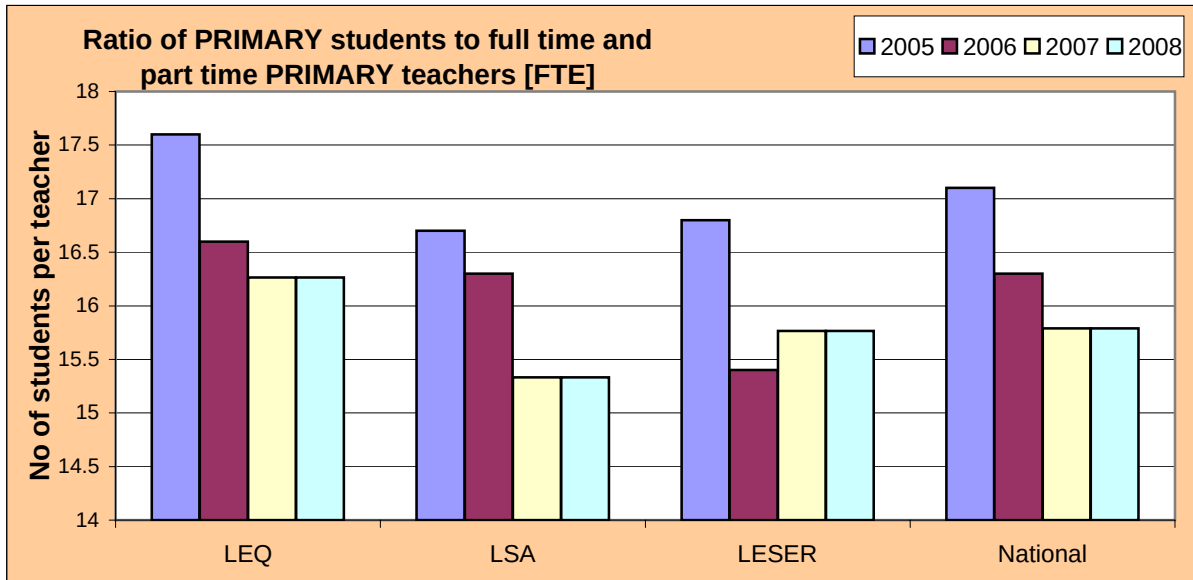

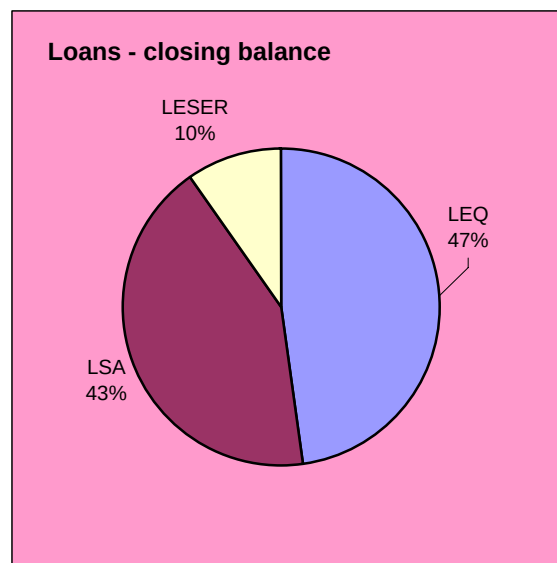
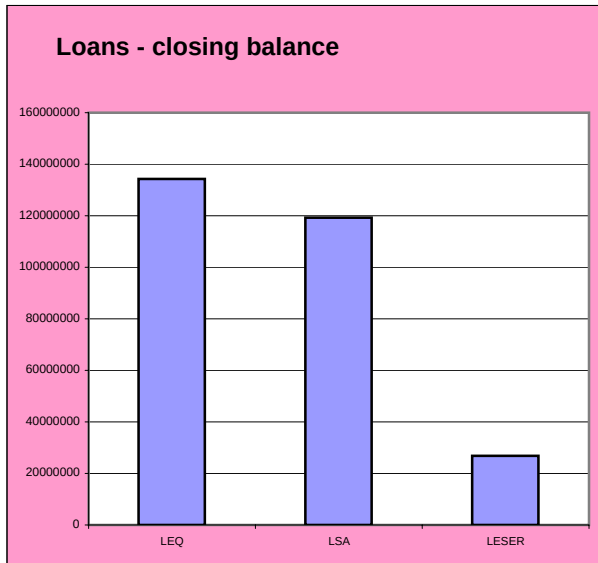
Financial Data as at 31 December 2007 (Recurrent)



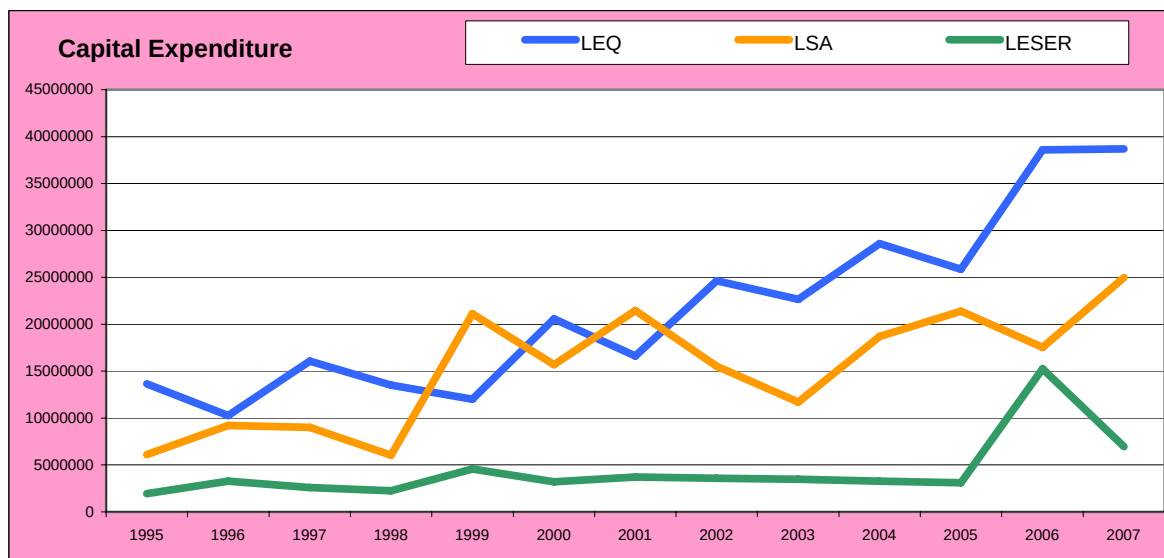
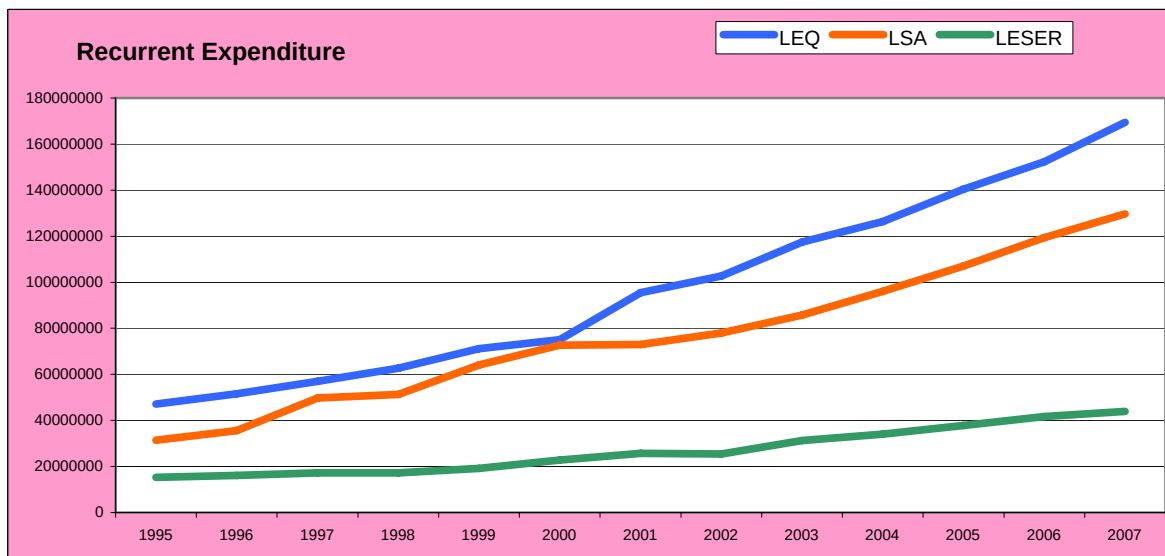
Financial Data as at 31 December 2007 (Capital purposes)



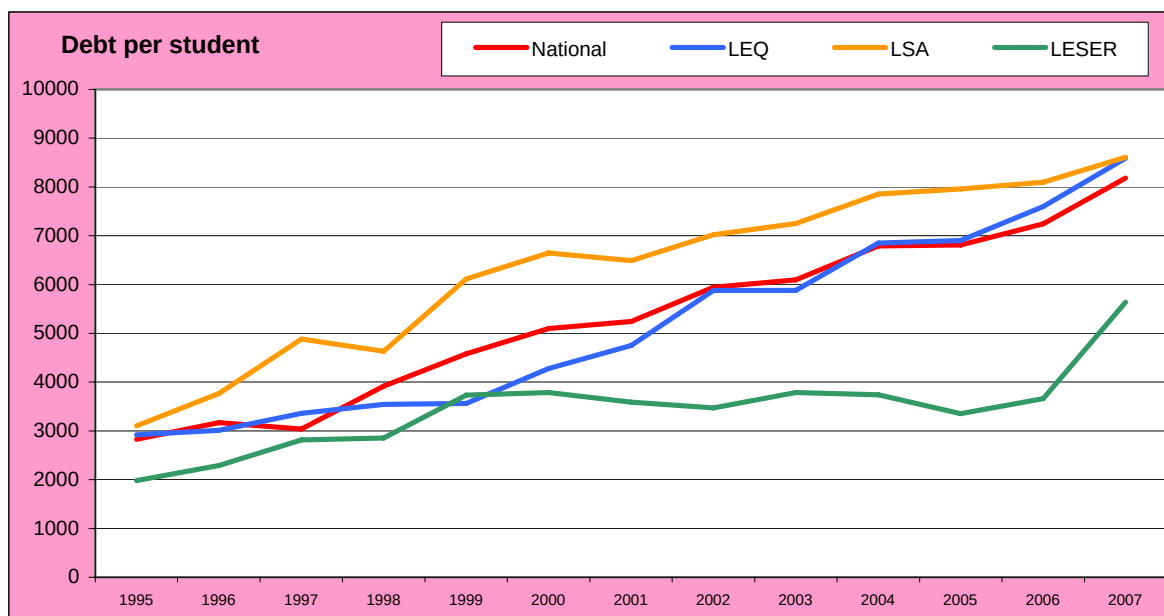
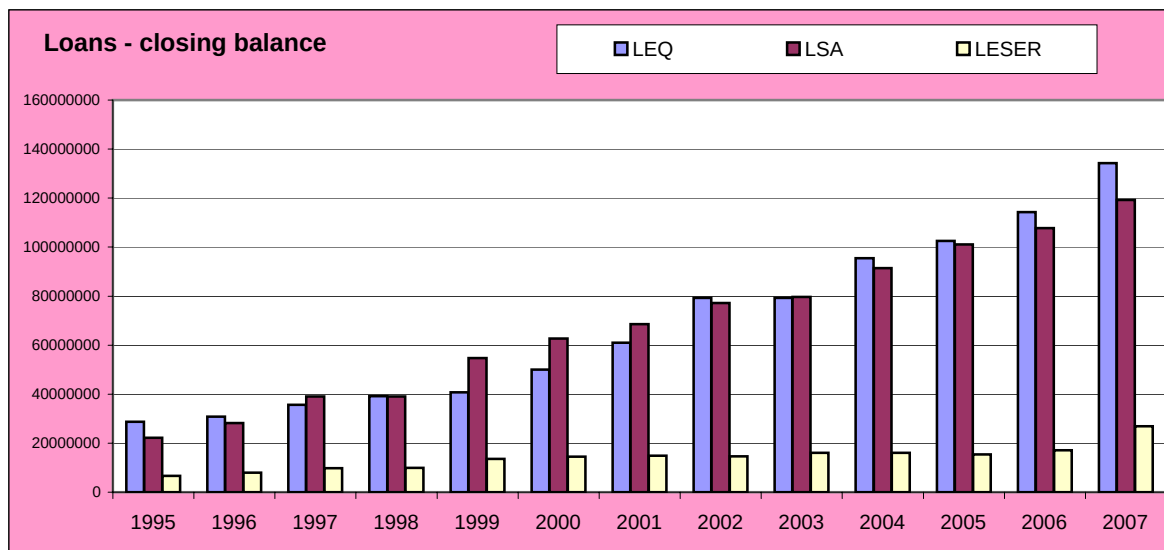
Financial Data as at 31 December 2007 (Loans)



Financial Data TRENDS 1995-2007



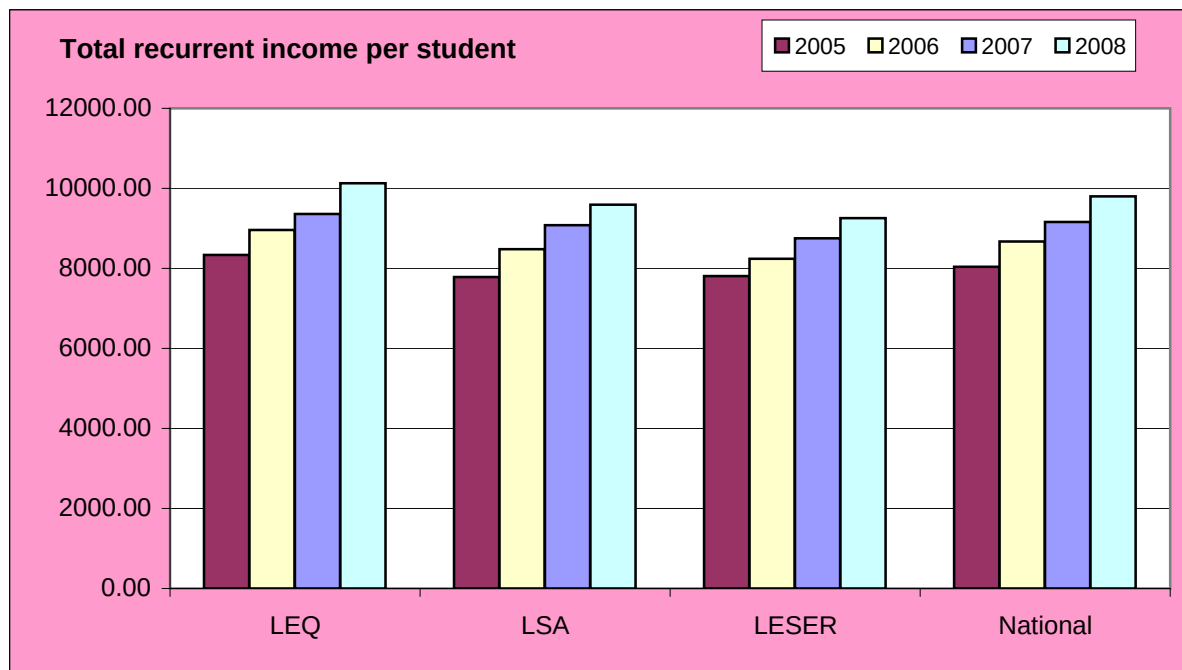

Total capital expenditure per student

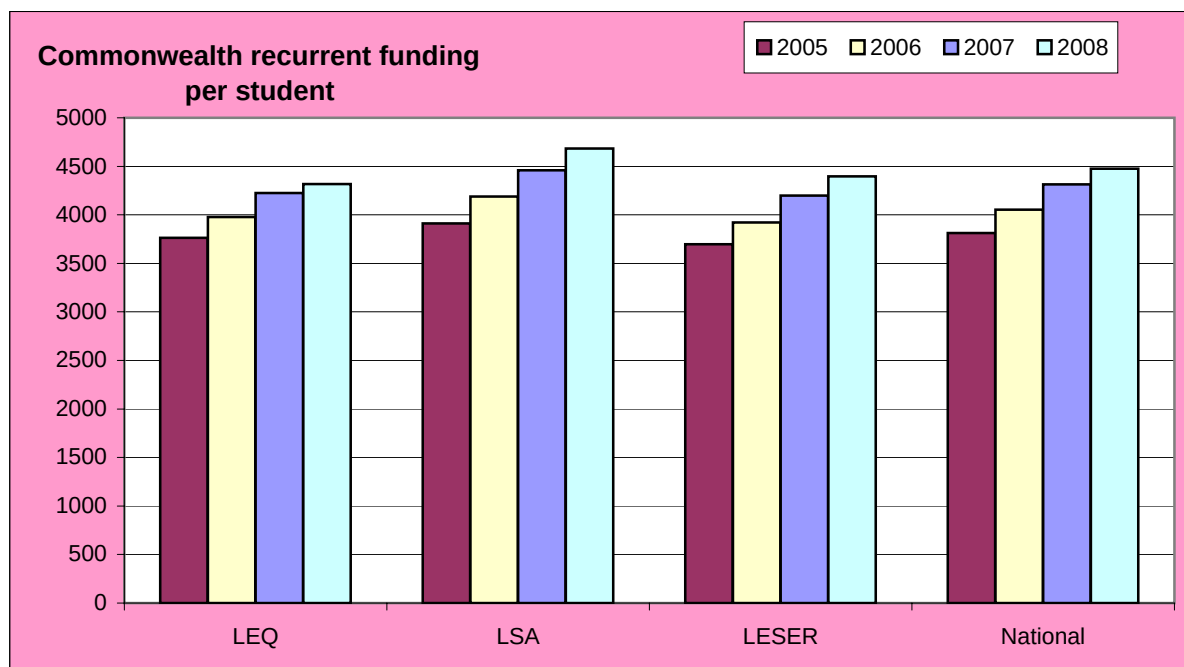
