Lindsay Bovill

For services to Lutheran schooling 1998 – 2018

The Lutheran Church of Australia thankfully acknowledges the faithful and committed service of Lindsay Bovill to Lutheran schools for 21 years.

Lindsay began his service to Lutheran education when he joined the staff of Concordia College, Toowoomba Qld, as Business Manager in 1998. Lindsay served in this role for five years until 2003 when he was appointed Business Manager at Luther College, Croydon Vic. Lindsay served at Luther for seven years, until his appointment to Trinity Lutheran College, Ashmore Qld, in a similar role. In 2012 Lindsay was appointed as General Manager St Peters Lutheran College Indooroopilly and Springfield, a role he dutifully carried out until his retirement at the end of 2018.

Lindsay has faithfully served in his roles as Business Manager and General Manager always striving to improve the business operations in order to improve the schools in which he served. He understood the financial pressures facing families when it came to paying fees and his empathetic and compassionate approach to assisting families in financial distress has been a hallmark of his career. He has an eye for detail and aesthetics and the beautification and enhancement of physical campuses will be a lasting legacy of Lindsay's.
