Rex Paschke

For services to Lutheran schooling 1993 - 2020

The Lutheran Church of Australia thankfully acknowledges the faithful and committed service of Rex Paschke to Lutheran schools for 26 years.

Rex Paschke began as a teacher at the St John's Lutheran Primary School (now knows as the St John's Campus) in 1993. He then commenced his role on the Concordia Campus as a Teacher in February 2005, leading the year 7 team as year 7 team leader. In 2006 he taught physical education and year 8 technology studies. Rex then held casual teaching positions until 2008 when he was appointed as the part-time workshop technician, a position he has held until this year.

Rex was integral in the relocation of year 7 students from St John's Lutheran Primary School to Concordia College, as he had both the experience of teaching at this level as well as the confidence of the parents.
