For service to Lutheran education 1981 – 2022

Lutheran Education Australia thankfully recognises the faithful and committed service of Greg Schneider to Lutheran Education for 41 years.

Greg commenced his service in Lutheran Education in 1981 when he was appointed as a teacher at Bethania Lutheran Primary School in Queensland. Greg served at Bethania for two years prior to accepting a teaching position in 1984 at Horsham Lutheran Primary School in Victoria. Greg served at Horsham Lutheran Primary School for 13 years; five as a classroom teacher and eight years as Principal.

In 1997 Greg was appointed as Principal of Good Shepherd Lutheran Primary School, Croydon Hills, and served at Good Shepherd as Principal for the next 26 years, before retiring at the end of 2022.

During Greg's leadership at Good Shepherd, the School has developed a reputation as a highly regarded leader in primary school education. He has been committed to the professional learning of teachers and the growth of future school leaders.
