For service to Lutheran education 1980 – 2022

Jane commenced her service in Lutheran Education in 1980 when she was appointed as a teacher at Bethania Lutheran Primary School in Queensland. Jane served at Bethania Lutheran Primary School for three years, prior to accepting a teaching position at Southport Lutheran Primary School for the 1983 school year.

In 1984 Jane was appointed as a teacher to Horsham Lutheran Primary School in Victoria. Jane served at Horsham in a number of roles; Classroom Teacher, Teacher Librarian and Special Education Teacher, over the next 13 years.
