The following table provides an overview of the extent of Lutheran education institutions and centres in Australia in 2012. There were 86 schools and 52 early childhood centres.

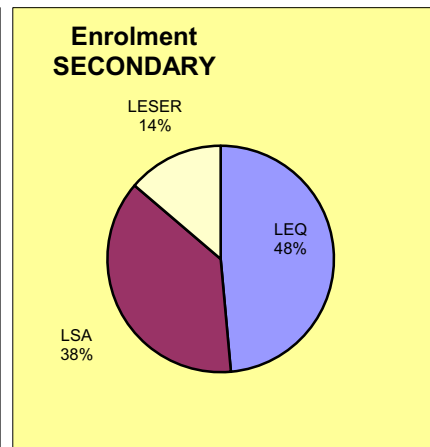
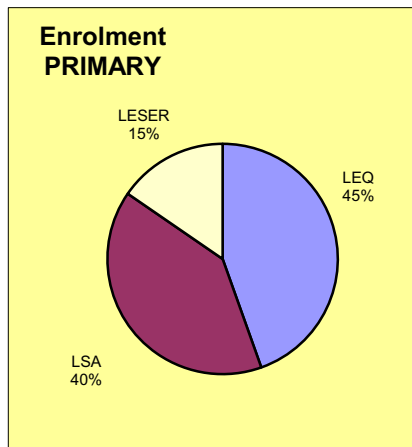
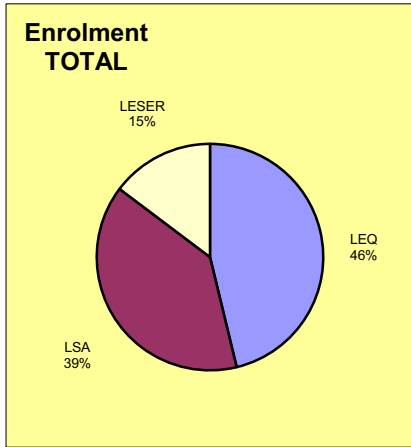

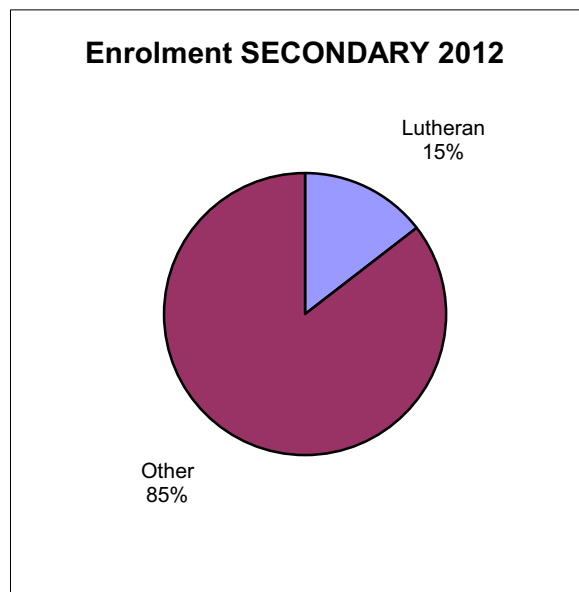
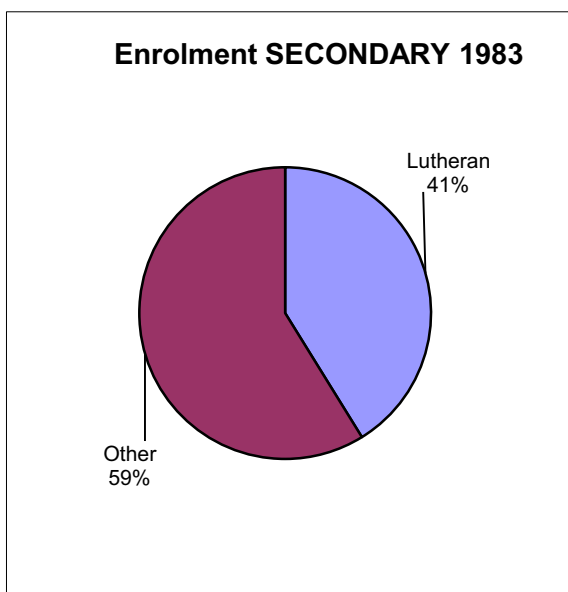
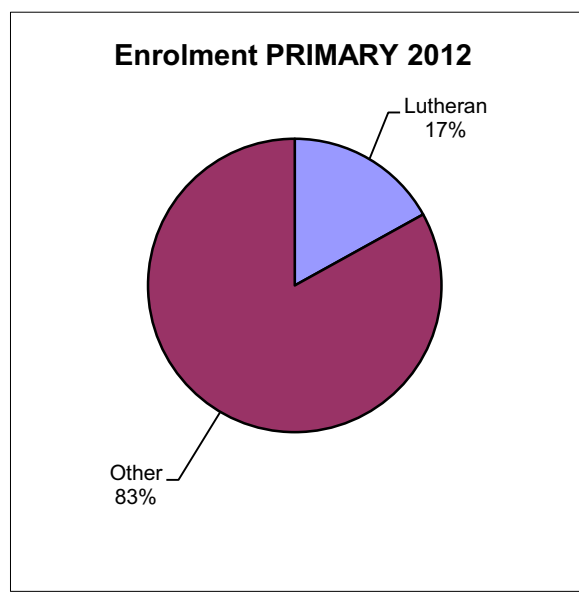
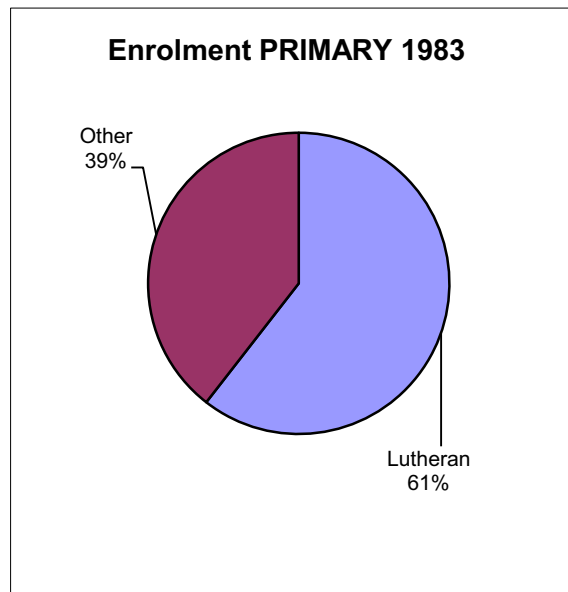
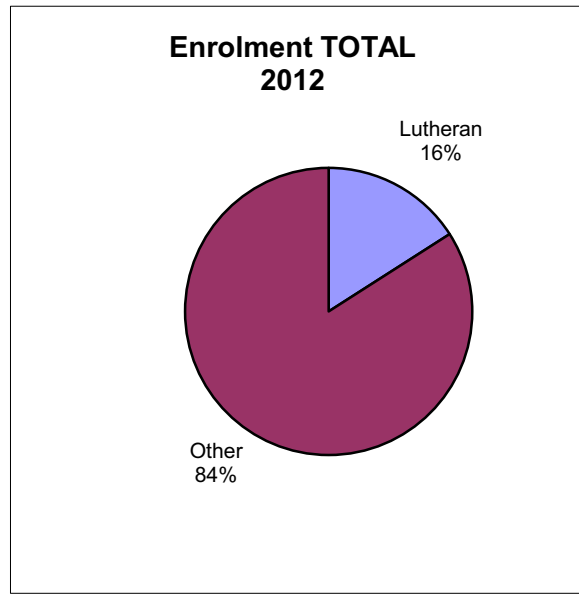
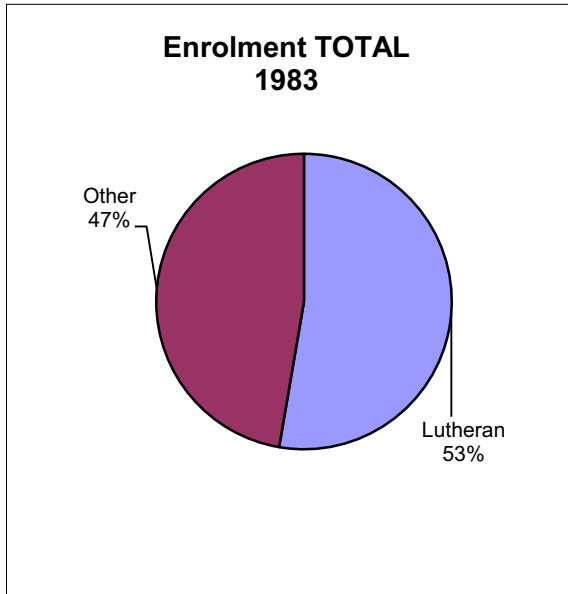
# TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2012 National



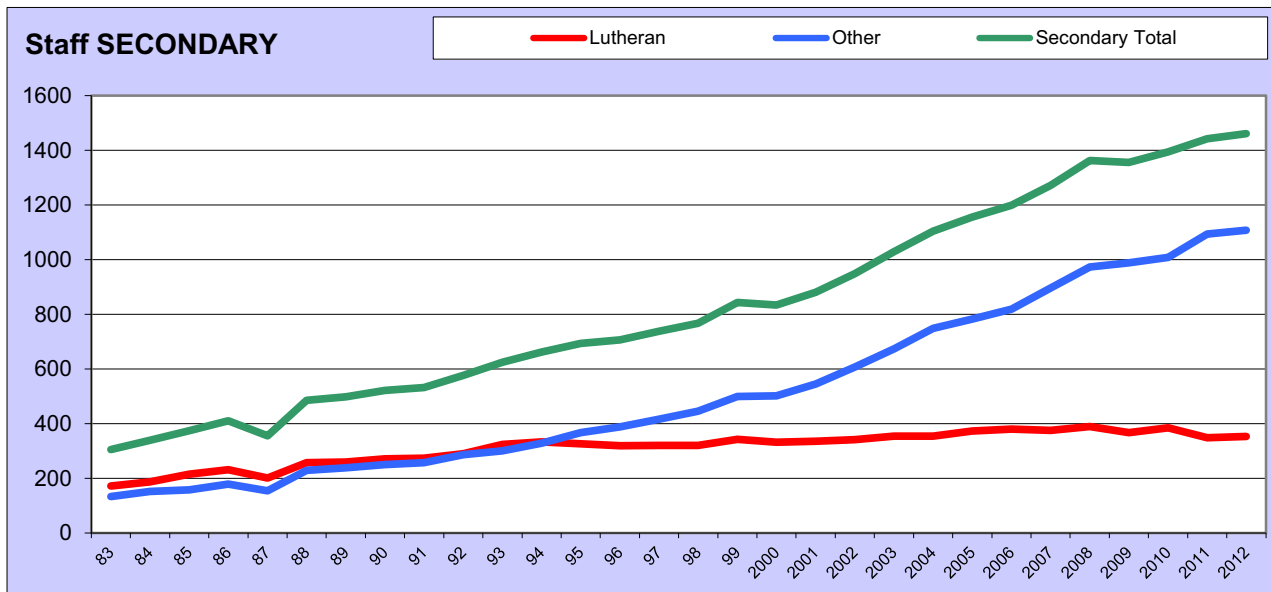
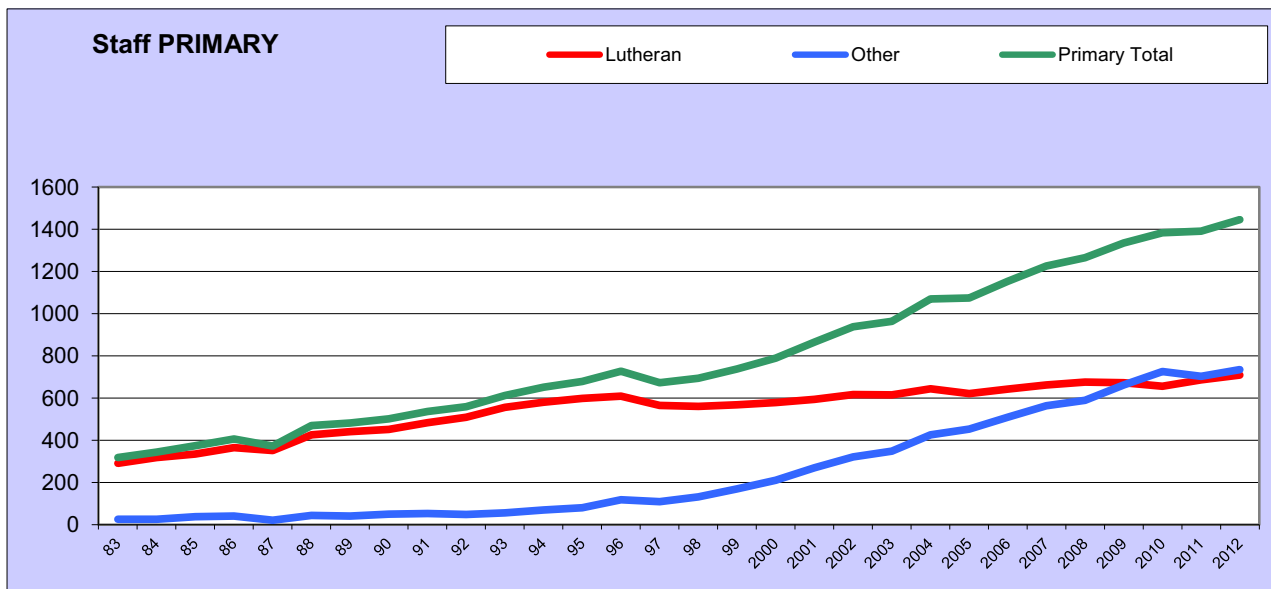
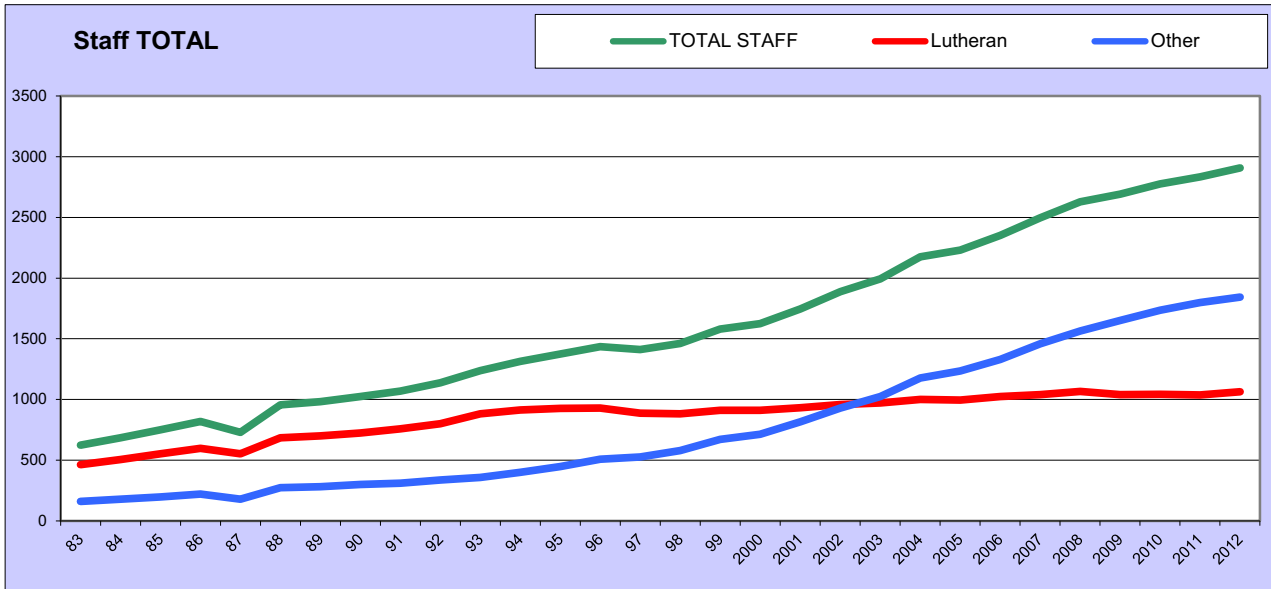
# TRENDS Enrolments 1983 - 2012 by region



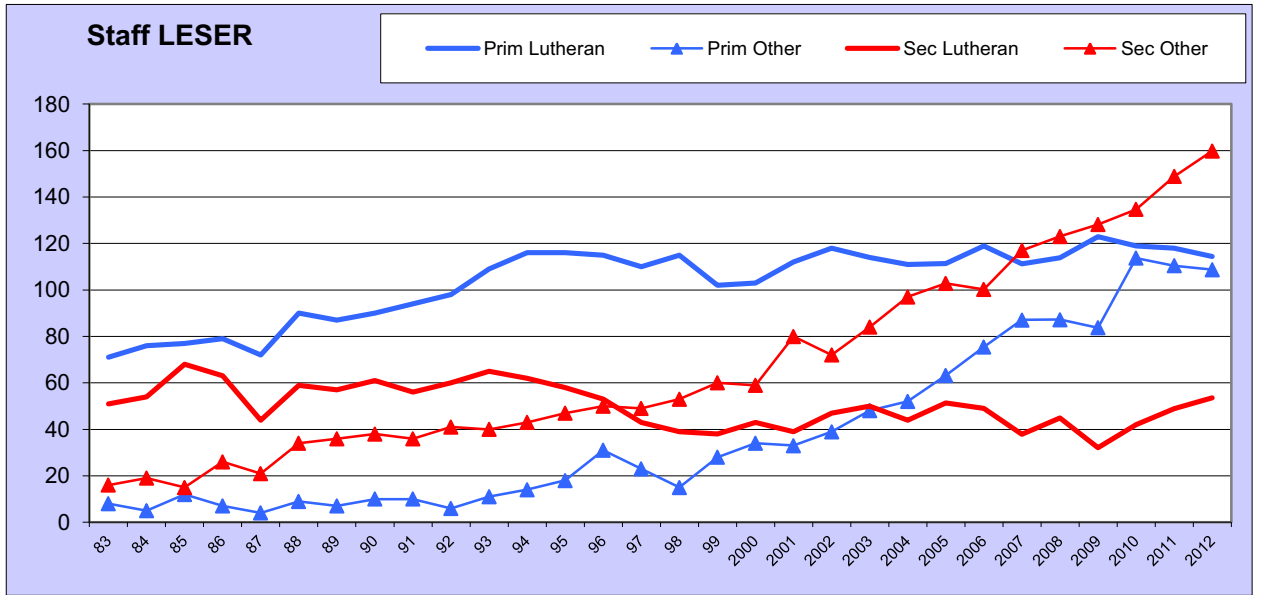
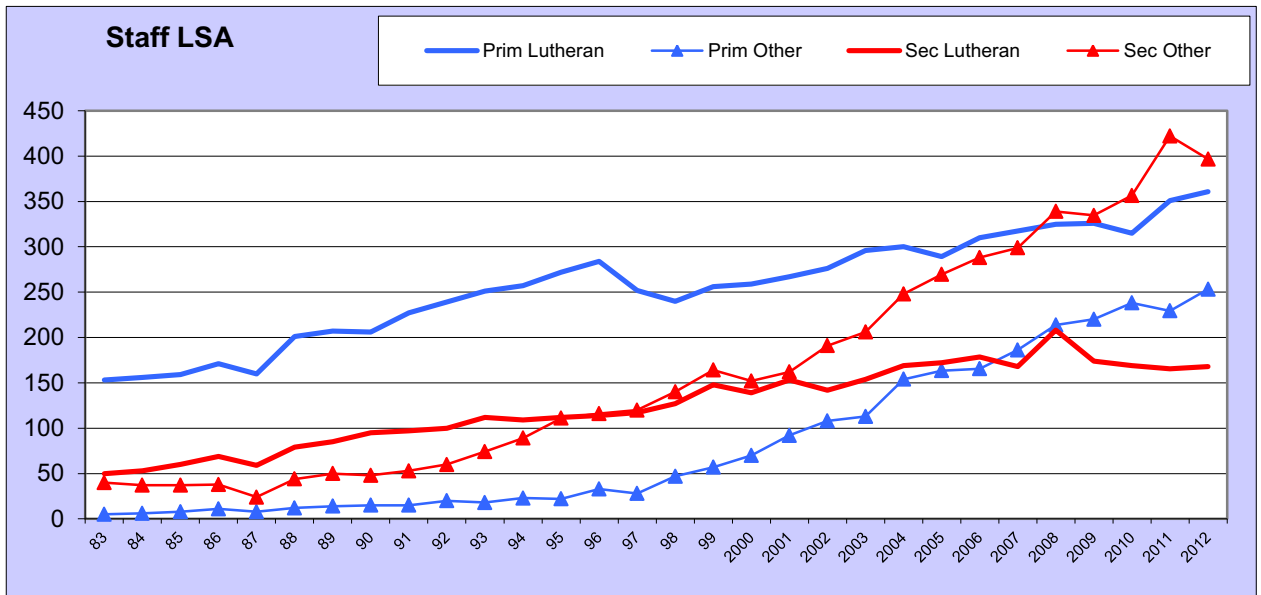
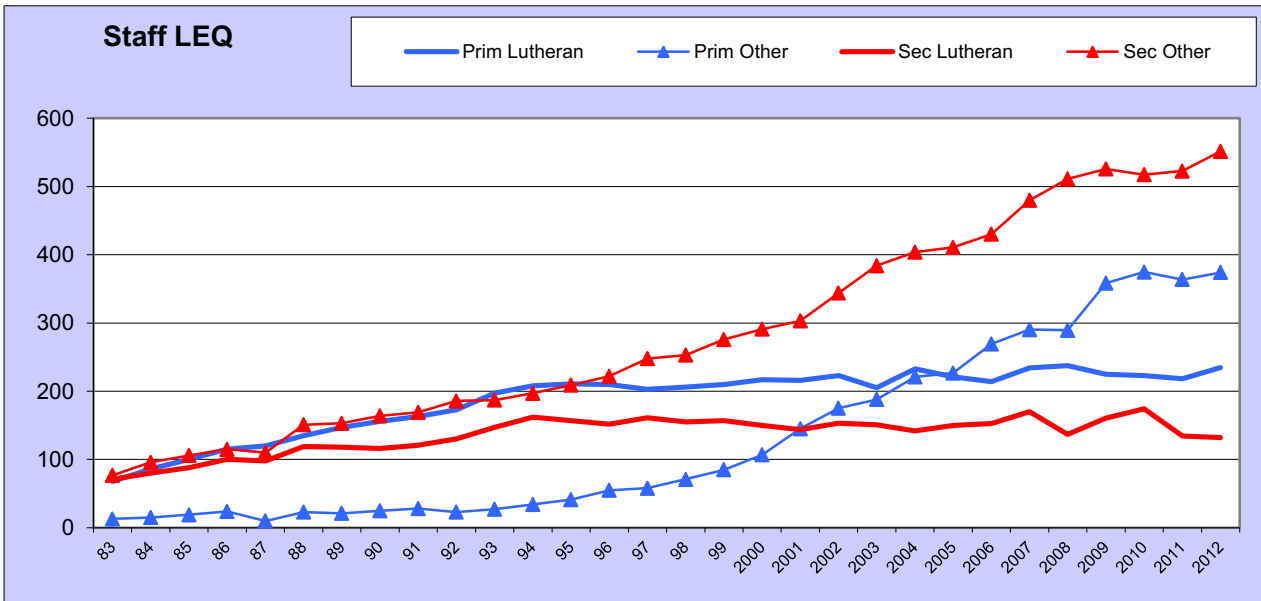

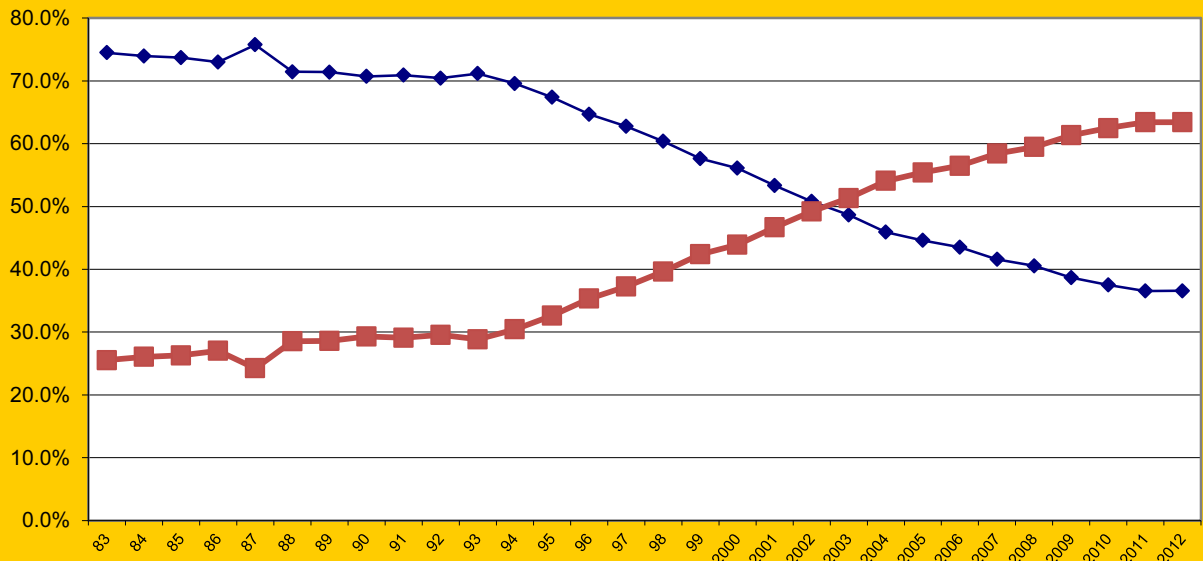
## National Enrolment Percentages

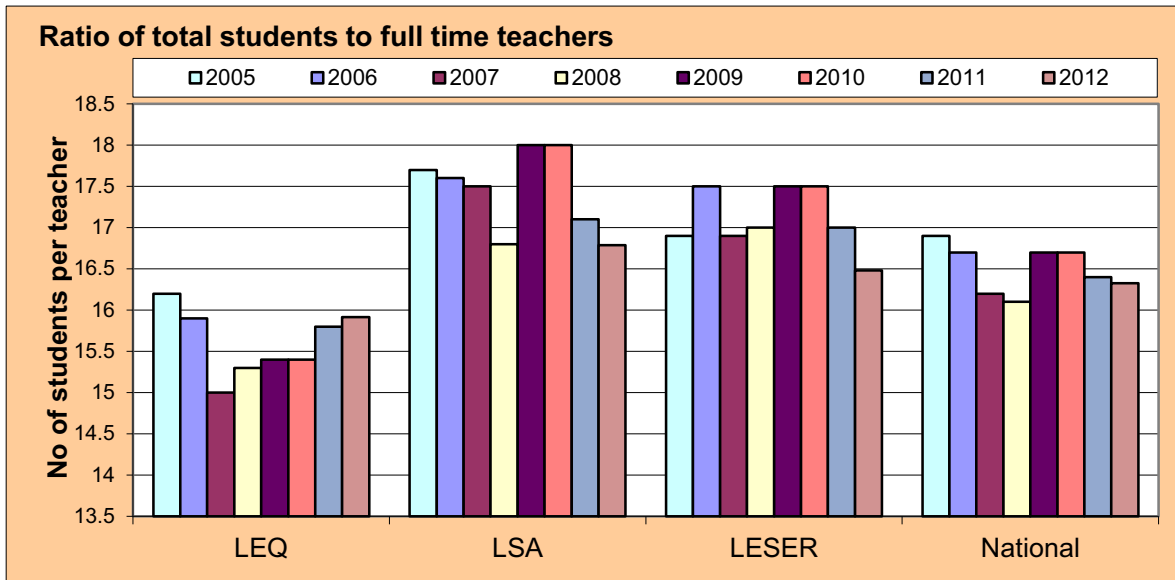

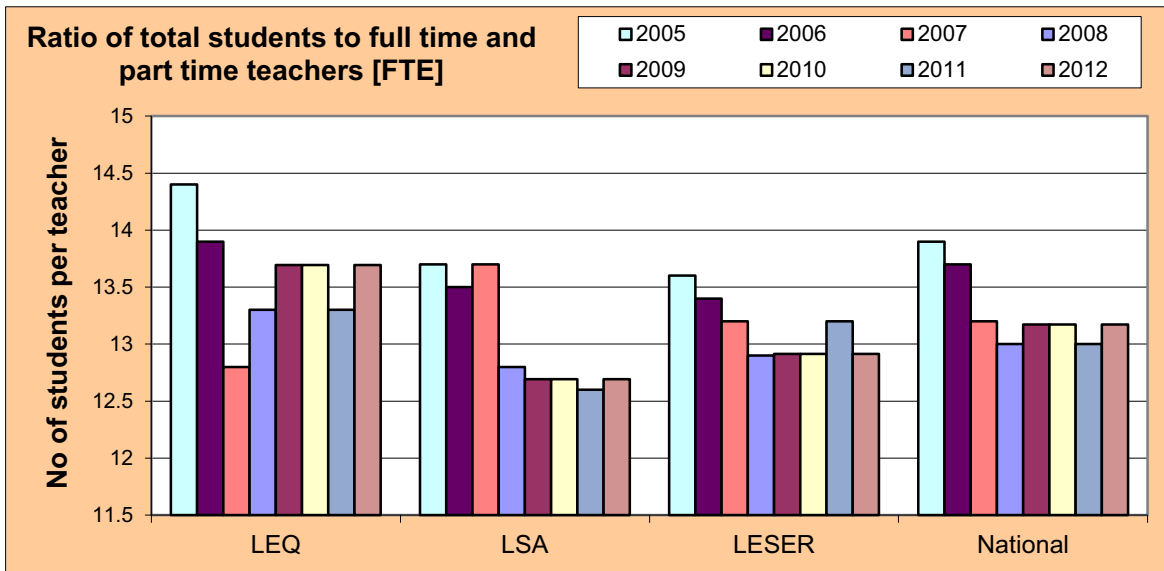

Ratio of students to full time and part time teachers [FTE]

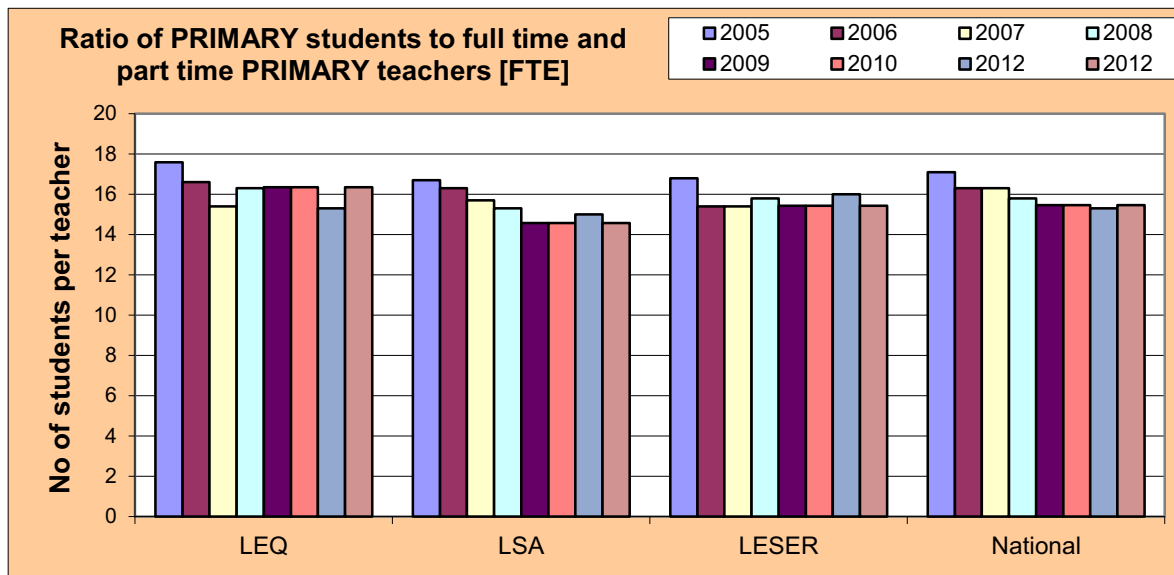

## Early childhood sector

In its consideration of the recommendations of Lyndal Mayer's report on Early Childhood Education and Care Services, in August 2010 the College of Directors noted:

***Early Childhood Education and Care Services Report***

*It was felt that the report prepared by L. Mayer had a Queensland thrust. LSA are happy to accept the report and its recommendations. The unity of LESER ECECS needs to be built and strengthened. The report highlights implications for staffing in the early childhood sector particularly in relation to accreditation and the teaching of Christian Studies. In order to identify the extent of ECECS a formula is to be agreed which will define the age groups and year levels to be included nationally. It is clear that ECECS fall under the umbrella of LEA and this sector needs to be included in key messages.*

These issues are now largely being taken up by the LEA Early Childhood Education Working Party. At its initial meeting in November 2011 the Working Party noted the issues relating to collecting data on a national basis. This working party will meet again during the second half of 2013.

The latest data indicate:

- In March 2011, Queensland early childhood services report having a licenced capacity of 2444, with 4583 children attending weekly. These figures include both *early childhood services* and *out of school hours care services*
- LSA kindergarten enrolments are around 420. LSA figures do not include *out of school hours care services* or *early learning centre* enrolments
- LESER kindergarten and childcare enrolments are around 220 LESER figures do not include *out of school hours care services* *early learning centre* enrolments
