Kathy embarked on her journey in Lutheran education in 1982 as a teacher at Bethany Preschool and Kindergarten, Woongoolba. After four years, she transitioned to Good News Lutheran Primary School, Middle Park. Taking a break to start her family, Kathy later resumed her career at Faith Lutheran College, Redlands, St Mark's Lutheran School, Mt Barker, and Redeemer Lutheran School, Rochedale, where she assumed the role of Head of Middle Years. Relocating to the Redcliffe Peninsula in 2014, Kathy served diligently for 10 years as the Deputy Principal at Grace Lutheran Primary School.

Kathy's genuine heart for people has made her beloved in all her schools by staff, parents, and students. Her effective communication ensured that the Christian nature of Lutheran education was clearly understood by parents, staff, and students alike. Kathy's personal commitment to her Christian faith, reflected in her decision-making and daily interactions, has served as a shining example to many.
