For service to Lutheran education 1981 – 2023

The Lutheran Church of Australia thankfully acknowledges the faithful and committed service of Margie Whitbread to Lutheran education for 42 years.

Margie embarked on her Lutheran Education journey in 1981 at Lobethal Lutheran School. She continued her teaching career at St Paul's Lutheran School in Blair Athol before joining Immanuel Primary School in 1998, where she dedicated herself until her retirement.

At Immanuel Primary, Margie initially taught Year 7 and later transitioned to Year 6 in 2001. In 2006, she assumed the role of Assistant Principal Administration, efficiently overseeing various operational aspects of the school, including risk management, compliance, and timetabling.

Margie's expertise extended to developing key publications, such as the school's Yearbook, Staff and Parent Handbooks, and overseeing Newsletter production.
