For services to Lutheran schooling 1990 – 2021

The Lutheran Church of Australia thankfully acknowledges the faithful and committed service of Adrian Wiles to Lutheran education for over 30 years.

Adrian commenced his service in Lutheran Education in 1990 when he was appointed as Principal of Good Shepherd College, Hamilton Vic, which marked the beginning of his exemplary career as a leader at some of the country's largest Lutheran schools. Adrian's wealth of experience was developed and shared through his service as Principal at Immanuel Lutheran College Buderim, Queensland; Luther College, Croydon, Victoria; St Peters Lutheran College Indooroopilly, Queensland; and at Concordia Lutheran College, Toowoomba Queensland.

Adrian has ably led the Concordia community through the COVID-19 pandemic with a calm, steady hand. His outstanding leadership during this difficult time resulted in Concordia successfully navigating the challenges and continuing to grow and move forward in uncertain times.

Throughout his time as Principal at Concordia, Adrian has always kept his foot in the classroom through teaching and is always a favourite and beloved teacher of the students. Adrian has often been seen strumming the guitar at Chapel or visiting the Kindy students at Bush Kindy. Adrian is also known for his approachable personality. He is always ready for a chat or a joke with students, staff and parents.
