Gifts and talents

- Prior to the worship time, invite each class to brainstorm gifts and talents they can identify in each other. Write each one on a separate card. Display these in the worship space.
- In addition, invite each student to write a gift or talent of their own on a piece of paper and fold it. This they take to worship for the symbolic action (slide 12)
- Prepare a list of gifts and talents (selected) for the worship leader to use as a reference in the symbolic action.
