In this 2 hour workshop, there will be 2 discrete elements and foci. During the first hour, the participants will be joined by the Business Managers Mini-conference participants to hear from a leading economist whose attendance has been generously sponsored by Westpac. This address will give us an indication of the Australian and World economic outlooks in both the medium and long term to assist us in strategic planning at the local school level.

In the second hour, we will be examining the principles of good corporate governance in the not-for-profit sector and looking at what these principles mean in practice as we look to ensure all Lutheran schools have governance structures, systems and processes that protect, grow and guide out schools into the future.

This mini-conference is ideally suited to those currently in governance roles in our schools, those seeking to act in a governance role in the future, and those who report directly to school councils.
